SCHOOL EDUCATION ACT 1999**DECLARATION OF LOCAL-INTAKE AREAS FOR SCHOOLS WITH PRIMARY STUDENTS**

(Pursuant to Sections 60, 78, 79 and 80)

The Hon. Minister for Education has declared that the local-intake areas for the schools listed hereunder shall be as stated in this notice. Children of compulsory school age who reside within the local-intake areas stated shall be entitled to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply if there is an appropriate educational program for them at that school. Children who reside outside these local-intake areas may apply to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply.

BALER PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Collier Drive and Masters Way, north along Masters Way (east side included) to Murdoch Drive, north east along Murdoch Drive (south side included) to Banksia Street, northwest along Banksia Street (both sides excluded) to Kennedy Street, in a general north westerly and northerly direction along Kennedy Street (east side included) to Cottier Drive, north east along Cottier Drive (both sides excluded) to Dale Street, north east along Dale Street (east side included) to Traine Crescent, northwest along Traine Crescent (both sides excluded) to the southern boundary of Lot 2334 on the eastern side of Traine Crescent, northeast along the south eastern boundaries of Lots 2334 and 2333 to the northern extremity of Catamore Court, continuing northeast along the south eastern boundary of Lot 1, through the intersection of Brodie Crescent and Guard Way to the eastern extremity of Edkins Place, along the south eastern boundaries of Lots 2145 and 2144, to and across Greene Place to North Circular Road, and then in an easterly and south easterly direction along North Circular Road (both sides included) to Murdoch Drive.

BERTRAM PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of the Kwinana Freeway and Mortimer Road, west along Mortimer Road (north side included) to Bertram Road, continuing west along Bertram Road (north side included) to Challenger Avenue, north west along Challenger Avenue (north side included) to the railway line, north east along the railway line to a point on the western extension of the east-west alignment of the southern arm of Darton Loop, east along this extension and Darton Loop (both sides excluded) to Price Parkway, east along Millbrook Avenue and its eastern extension to the drain, north east along the drain to Sulphur Road, east along Sulphur Road (south side included) to Holden Close, east along Holden Close (south side included) to the Kwinana Freeway and south along the Kwinana Freeway (west side included) to Mortimer Road.

The following defines an optional area for Bertram Primary School and North Parmelia Primary School—

From the junction of Price Parkway and Darton Loop, west along Darton Loop (both sides included) and its extension to the railway line, north along the railway line to Sulphur Road, east along Sulphur Road (south side included) and its extension to the drain, south west along the drain, to the eastern extension of Millbrook Avenue, west along the this extension and west along Millbrook Avenue (both sides included) to the junction of Price Parkway and Darton Loop.

The following defines an optional area for Bertram Primary School and Medina Primary School—

From the junction of Wellard Road and Bertram Road, south east along Wellard Road (north and east sides included) to Telephone Lane, east along Telephone Lane (north sides included) to the Kwinana Freeway, north along the Kwinana Freeway (west sides included) to Millar Road, east along Millar Road (both sides included) and its south east extension to the north west extension of Duckpond Road, south east along Duckpond Road (both sides included) to Banksia Road, north east and north west along Banksia Road (both sides included) to Lydon Road, north east along Lydon Road (both sides included) to Casuarina Road, north along Casuarina Road (both sides included) to Mortimer Road, west along Mortimer Road (south side included) to Bertram Road, north west and west along Bertram Road (south sides included) to Challenger Road, north west along Challenger Road (south west side included) to the proposed railway line, south west along the proposed railway line to Wellard Road and east along Wellard Road to the junction with Bertram Road.

The following defines an optional area for Bertram Primary School, Medina Primary School and North Parmelia Primary School—

From the intersection of the Kwinana Freeway and Thomas Road, east along Thomas Road (south side included) to the local government boundary between the Town of Kwinana and the Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale, south along this local government boundary to Mortimer Road, west along Mortimer Road (north side included) to the Kwinana Freeway and north along the Kwinana Freeway (east side included) to Thomas Road.

BROOME PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From Entrance Point, north along Kabbarli Road (both sides included) to Port Drive, north along Port Drive (east side included), in a generally northerly direction along Port Drive to the three

way junction of Port Drive, Frederick Street and Cable Beach Road (East), north from this junction to the northern property boundary of the Broome International Airport, south east along the northern property boundary of the Airport to Gus Winckel Drive, generally south east and east along Gus Winckel Drive (both sides excluded) to Broome Highway, east from this junction to the mouth of Dampier Creek and generally south along the coastline to Entrance Point.

The area north of the following boundary is an optional area for Broome Primary School and Roebuck Primary School—

From a point at Dampier Creek on the eastward extension of Gubinge Road, west along this extension to Broome Highway and west along Gubinge Road (north side only) to Fairway Drive, north west along Fairway Drive (both sides included) to the junction of Lullfitz Drive and Frangipani Drive, continuing north west from this junction to the coastline of the Indian Ocean.

CABLE BEACH PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From Entrance Point, north along Kabbarli Road (both sides included) to Port Drive, north along Port Drive (east side included), in a generally northerly direction along Port Drive to the three way junction of Port Drive, Frederick Street and Cable Beach Road (East), north from this junction to a point due north of the junction of Frederick Street, Cable Beach Road (East) and Port Drive, north from this point to a point due east of the junction of Gubinge Road and Murray Road, due west from this point to the aforesaid junction, north west and west along Murray Road (south side only) to Cable Beach Road (West) and the westward extension of Murray Road to the coastline of the Indian Ocean, and south along the coastline to Entrance Point.

The following defines an optional area for Cable Beach Primary School and Roebuck Primary School—

From a point on the coastline of Indian Ocean on the westward extension of Murray Road, east along this westward extension of Murray Road, east and south east along Murray Road (north side included) to Gubinge Road, east along Gubinge Road (north side included) to Fairway Drive, north west along Fairway Drive (both sides included) to the junction of Lullfitz Drive and Frangipani Drive, continuing north west from this junction to the coastline of the Indian Ocean, and south along the coastline to the point on the westward extension of Murray Road.

CASSIA PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Forrest Circle and Collier Road, north east and generally north along Forrest Circle (eastern side included) to the junction of Forrest Circle and Cottier Drive, east and north along Cottier Drive (both sides excluded) to Kennedy Street, in a general south easterly direction along Kennedy Street (south west side included) to Banksia Street, east and southeast along Banksia Street (both sides included) to Murdoch Drive, south west along Murdoch Drive (north west side included) to Masters Way and south along Masters Way (west side included) to Collier Road.

CAVERSHAM PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Reid Highway and West Swan Road, south along West Swan Road (east side included) to the Swan River foreshore, generally north east along the Swan River foreshore to Maali Bridge, north west from Maali Bridge to the eastern end of Douglas Road, west along Douglas Road (both sides included) to West Swan Road, south west along West Swan Road (both sides included) to Woollcott Avenue, north west and along Woollcott Avenue (both sides included) and its western extension to Lord Street, south along Lord Street (east side included) to Harrow Street, west to the boundary of Whiteman Park, generally west and south along the boundary of Whiteman Park to Marshall Road, west along Marshall (south side included) to Bennett Brook, south along Bennett Brook to Reid Highway and east along Reid Highway to West Swan Road.

The following defines an optional area between Caversham Primary School and East Beechboro Primary School—

From the intersection of Reid Highway and West Swan Road, south along West Swan Road (west side included) to Benara Road, west along Benara Road (north side included) to Waldeck Road, north along Waldeck Road (both sides excluded) to its northern point, north to the junction of Reid Highway and Lord Street, and east along Reid Highway (south side included) to West Swan Road.

DALKEITH PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Vincent Street and Melvista Avenue, east along Melvista Avenue (south side included) to Bruce Street, south along Bruce Street (west side included) to the junction of Bruce Street and The Avenue, south east from this point along the locality boundary of Nedlands and Dalkeith to the Swan River foreshore, southwest and northwest along the river foreshore to the western extension of Watkins Road, east along Watkins road (both sides included) to Parker Road, north along Parker Road (both sides included) to Melvista Avenue, east along Melvista Avenue (south side included) to Bostock Road, north along Bostock Avenue (both sides included) to Princess Road, east along Princess Road (south side included) to Taylor Road, north along Taylor Road (both sides included) to Barcoo Avenue, west along Barcoo Avenue (both sides included) to Vincent Street, south along Vincent Street (west side included) to Melvista Avenue.

EAST DALYELLUP PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following will define the local-intake area for this school when it opens in 2013—

From the junction of Dalyellup Boulevard and Murtin Road, north along the northern extension of Dalyellup Boulevard to Centenary Road, east along Centenary Road (both sides excluded) across Bussell Highway to the northern extension of Jules Road, south along this extension and Jules Road (both sides included) to Hastie Road, west and northwest along Hastie Road (north side included) to the Bussell Highway, and continuing north west across Norton Promenade to the junction of Kambany Approach and Koonak Street, west along Koonak Street (both sides excluded) to Dalyellup Boulevard, north along Dalyellup Boulevard (both sides excluded) to Murtin Road.

EATON PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of the Australind Bypass and Eaton Drive, north along Eaton Drive (west side only) to Hands Avenue, generally north along Hands Avenue (west side only) and its northern extension to the Collie River foreshore, west along the Collie River foreshore to Pelican Point at the Leschenault Inlet, south along the Leschenault Inlet foreshore to the south western property boundary of Foreshore Park, south east along the south western boundary of Foreshore Park, and continuing south east along the western property boundary of The Sanctuary Resort Golf Course to the railway line, south east along the railway line to the Australind Bypass and north east along the Australind Bypass (north west side included) to Eaton Drive.

FRESHWATER PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the Loch Street railway station, to and south along Loch Street (west side included) to Stirling Highway, east along Stirling Highway (south side included) to Vincent Street, south along Vincent Street (west side included) to Barcoo Avenue, west along Barcoo Avenue (both sides excluded) to Taylor Road (south along Taylor Road (both sides excluded) to Princess Road, west along Princess Road (north side included) to Bostock Road south along Bostock Road (both sides excluded) to Melvista Avenue, west along Melvista Avenue (north side included) to Parker Road, south along Parker Road (both sides excluded) to Watkins Road, west along Watkins Road (both sides excluded) to the Swan River foreshore, north and west along the Swan River foreshore to the eastern extension of Osborne Parade, west along the eastern extension of Osborne Parade to the junction of Osborne Parade and Richardson Avenue, north along Richardson Avenue (both sides excluded) to and across Stirling Highway to Parry Street, north along Parry Street (east side included) to the railway line, north east along the railway line to the Loch Street railway station.

The following defines an optional area between Hollywood Primary School and Freshwater Primary School—

From the intersection of Loch Street and Stirling Highway, north along Loch Street (east side included) to Government Road, east along Government Road (both sides included) to Robinson Street, south along Robinson Street (both sides included) to Stirling Highway and west along Stirling Highway (north side included) to Loch Street.

The following defines an optional area between Freshwater Primary School and Swanbourne Primary School—

From the corner of Stirling Road and Claremont Crescent, west along Claremont Crescent (both sides included) to a point where the southern extension of Wright Avenue meets the railway line, north through Scotch College to Wright Avenue, continuing north along Wright Avenue (both sides included) to Bellevue Terrace, east along Bellevue Terrace and its extension to the north-south bike-path on the south western side of Lake Claremont, south along the bike-path and continuing south along Stirling Road (west side included) to Claremont Crescent.

The following defines an optional area between Freshwater Primary School and Mount Claremont Primary School—

From the intersection of Stirling Road and Shenton Road, north along Stirling Road (east side included) and its northern extension to the bike-path, north along the bike-path to a point on the western extension of Lapsley Road, east along this extension to Lapsley Road, east along Lapsley Road (both sides included) and its easterly extension to the railway line south and south west along the railway line to Stirling Road and north along Stirling Road (east side included) to Shenton Road.

GREENFIELDS PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Mandurah Road and Pinjarra Road, east along Pinjarra Road (north side included) to Lakes Road, north east along Lakes Road (west side included) to Murdoch Drive, in a westerly direction along Murdoch Drive (south side included) to Valentine Drive, north east along Valentine Drive (both sides excluded) to Cassilis Court, north between Cassilis Court and Takura Close on the east and Esprit Parkway on the west to and across Waldron Boulevard, continuing north between Royce Road and Perida Way to Exchequer Avenue, in a general westerly direction along Exchequer Avenue (both sides included) to Bortolo Drive, north along Bortolo Drive (both sides excluded) to Exchequer Avenue, north west from this junction along the bike-path and its western extension to the junction of Mandurah Road and Manjoogordap Drive, south along Mandurah Road (east side included) to Pinjarra Road.

The following defines an optional area between Greenfields Primary School and Riverside Primary School—

From the junction of Lakes Road and Murdoch Drive, west along Murdoch Drive (north side included) to Valentine Drive, north east along Valentine Drive (both sides included) to Cassilis Court, north between Cassilis Court and Takura Close (both on the east) and Esprit Parkway (on the west), to and across Waldron Boulevard continuing north between Royce Road and Perida Way to and across Exchequer Avenue between Korbel Close (on the west) and Norwich Close (on the east) and continuing east between Copperfield Close, Kingscote Place, Exeter Place and Redbank Rise (all on the north) and Norwich Close, Sunderland Close, Everton Place and Brighton Place (all on the south) to Lakes Road, south along Lakes Road (west side included) to the junction with Murdoch Drive.

HOCKING PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following will define the local-intake area of this school from 2013—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Elliot Road, east along Elliot Road (south side included) to Benmuni Road, south along Benmuni Road (both sides included) to Jambanis Road, east along Jambanis Road (both sides included) to Badgerup Road, south along Badgerup Road (west side included) to Golfview, west along the Golfview (both sides included) to Benmuni Road, south along Benmuni Road (west side included) to Bebich Drive, west along Bebich Drive (north side included) to Lenore Road, north along Lenore Road (east side included) to Moscow Retreat, west along Moscow Retreat (both sides included) to Manchester Drive, west along Manchester Drive (both sides included and including the two cul-de-sacs) to Carsbrooke Loop, west along the southern arm of Carsbrooke Loop (both sides included) to Wanneroo Road and north along Wanneroo Road (east side included) to Elliot Road.

HOLLYWOOD PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the Loch Street railway station, to and south along Loch Street (east side included) to Government Road, east along Government Road (both sides excluded) to Robinson Street, south along Robinson Street (both sides excluded) to Stirling Highway, east along Stirling Highway (north side included) to Hampden Road, north along Hampden Road (west side included) to Park Road, east along Park Road (north side included) to Winthrop Avenue, north along Winthrop Avenue (west side included) to Aberdare Road, west along Aberdare Road (south side included) to the railway line, south west along the railway line to the Loch Street railway station.

The following defines an optional area between Hollywood Primary School and Freshwater Primary School—

From the intersection of Loch Street and Stirling Highway, north along Loch Street (east side included) to Government Road, east along Government Road (both sides included) to Robinson Street, south along Robinson Street (both sides included) to Stirling Highway and west along Stirling Highway (north side included) to Loch Street.

The following defines an optional area between Hollywood Primary School and Rosalie Primary School—

From the junction of Aberdare Road and Gairdner Drive, south along Gairdner Drive (both sides included) to Verdun Street, west along Verdun Street (north side included) to Campsie Street, north along Campsie Street (both sides included) to Aberdare Road and east along Aberdare Road (south side included) to Gairdner Drive.

LAKE MONGER PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Herdsman Parade and Collier Street, east along Collier Street (both sides excluded) to Daghish Street, south along Daghish Street (both sides excluded) to Wise Street, east along Wise Street (both sides excluded) and east through Lake Monger to the Mitchell Freeway, north west along the Mitchell Freeway (west side included) to a point on the southern extension of Brady street, north along this extension and north along Brady Street (both sides excluded) to Purslowe Street, west along Purslowe Street (both sides excluded) to the Mitchell Freeway, north west along the Mitchell Freeway (west side included) to Scarborough Beach Road, north west along Scarborough Beach Road (south west side included) to the junction with Hutton Street, south west from this junction through the Herdsman Business Park to the foreshore of Herdsman Lake, south east and south west along the foreshore of Herdsman Lake to a point on the north west extension of Telopea Lane and continuing south east along Telopea Lane (both sides excluded) to Herdsman Parade and north west along Herdsman Parade (both sides excluded) to the junction with Collier Street.

MARRI GROVE PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following will define the local-intake area of this school from 2013—

From the intersection of Forrest Road and Eleventh Road, south east along Eleventh Road (both sides excluded) to the railway line, south along the railway line to a point due east of the most northern point of the proposed Bett Road (currently the south west corner of the Cardup Nature Reserve), west from the railway to this point, north along the northern extension of Bett Road (part of which corresponds to the western side of the Cardup Nature Reserve) to Orton Road, generally east along Orton Road (south side included) to Warrington Road, north along Warrington Road (east side included) to Abernethy Road, west along Abernethy Road (north side included) to Briggs Road, north along Briggs Road (east side included) to Thomas Road, west

along Thomas Road (north side included) to Masters Road, generally north along Masters Road (east side included) to Rowley Road, west along Rowley Road (north side included) to the junction with Hopkinson Road, north along Rowley Road (east side included) and its northern extension to Forrest Road, and north east along Forrest Road (both sides excluded) to Eleventh Road.

The following is an optional area between Marri Grove and Byford Primary Schools—

From the junction of Eleventh Road and the South Western Highway, south along the South Western Highway to Norman Road, west along Norman Road to the railway line, north along the railway line to Eleventh Road and east along Eleventh Road to the South Western Highway. The boundary parts of Eleventh Road (south side), the South Western Highway (west side) and the boundary street of Norman Road (both sides) are included within the optional area.

The following is an optional area between Marri Grove, Mundijong and West Byford Primary Schools—

From the intersection of Bett Road and the railway line, north along Bett Road (both sides included) to its most northern point, east from this point (keeping Pollard Cross –both sides included- to the south) to the railway line, south along the railway line to the junction with another railway line, north west and west along the latter railway line to Bett Road.

The following is an optional area between Marri Grove and West Byford Primary Schools—

From the junction of Abernethy Road and Warrington Road, south along Warrington Road (west side included), to Orton Road, west along Orton Road (north side included) to Doley Road, north along Doley Road (east side included) to Abernethy Road and east along Abernethy Road (south side included) to Warrington Road.

MEADOW SPRINGS PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Mandurah Road and Watersun Drive, west along Watersun Drive (both sides excluded) to Riana Place, west along Riana Place (both sides excluded) and its western extension to the Indian Ocean coastline, north along the coast line to the western extension of George Hibbert Road, east along this extension and east along George Hibbert Road (both sides included) to Victor Drive, north along Victor Drive (both sides included) to Chieftain Pass, east along Chieftain Pass (both sides included) and its extension to Mandurah Road, north along Mandurah Road (east side included) to Bundaburra Avenue, east along Bundaburra Avenue (both sides included) and its easterly extension to the Kwinana Freeway, north east along the Kwinana Freeway (east side included) to the local government boundary between the City of Rockingham and the City of Mandurah, east along this local government boundary to the Serpentine River, south along the Serpentine River to Lakes Road, west along Lakes Road (north side included) and Gordon Road (north side included) to the railway line, south west along the railway line to the junction of Mandurah Road and Manjoogoordap Drive, generally north west along Mandurah Road (east side included) to Watersun Drive.

The following defines an optional area between Meadow Springs Primary School and Singleton Primary School—

From a point on the coastline of the Indian Ocean and on the western extension of George Hibbert Road, east along George Hibbert Road (both sides excluded) to Victor Drive, north along Victor Drive (both sides excluded) to Chieftan Pass, east along Chieftan Pass (both sides excluded) and its eastern extension to Mandurah Road, north along Mandurah Road (west side included) to Madora Beach Road, west along Madora Beach Road (south side included) to the Indian Ocean coastline and south along the coastline to the western extension of George Hibbert Road.

MOUNT CLAREMONT PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Rochdale Road and West Coast Highway, south east along Rochdale Road (south side included) to Stephenson Avenue, north east along Stephenson Avenue (east side included) to Underwood Avenue, west along Underwood Avenue (south side included) to Brockway Road, south along Brockway Road (west side included) to Lemnos Street, west along Lemnos Street (both sides excluded) to Selby Street, south east along Selby Street (west side included) to the railway line, south west along the railway line to the easterly extension of Lapsley Road, west along this extension and along Lapsley Road (both sided included) and its westerly extension to the bike –path on the western shoreline of Lake Claremont, north west and north along the bike-path to the southern end of Strickland Street, north along Strickland Street (east side included) to Asquith Street, west along Asquith Street (north side included) to Mayfair Street, north along Mayfair Street (east side included) to the northern boundary of the Cottesloe Golf club, west along this property boundary to West Coast Highway and north along West Coast Highway (east side included) to Rochdale Road.

The following defines an optional area between Swanbourne Primary School and Mount Claremont Primary School—

From the intersection of Asquith Street and Strickland Street, south along Strickland Street (west side included) to the bike-path on the western shoreline of Lake Claremont, west to the southern end of Butler Avenue, north along Butler Avenue (both sides included) to Alfred Road, west along Alfred Road (north side included) to the Cottesloe Golf Course, north along the eastern site boundary of the Cottesloe Golf Course to the western extension of Asquith Street, east along this extension and Asquith Street (south side included) to Strickland Street.

The following defines an optional area between Freshwater Primary School and Mount Claremont Primary School—

From the intersection of Stirling Road and Shenton Road, north along Stirling Road (east side included) and its northern extension to the bike-path, north along the bike-path to a point on the western extension of Lapsley Road, east along this extension to Lapsley Road, east along Lapsley Road (both sides included) and its easterly extension to the railway line south and south west along the railway line to Stirling Road and north along Stirling Road (east side included) to Shenton Road.

NEERABUP PRIMARY SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Joondalup Drive and Pinjar Road, north along Pinjar Road (east side included) to the locality boundary between Carramar and Banksia Grove, north along this locality boundary to Flynn Drive, east along Flynn Drive (south side included) to Old Yanchep Road, south along Old Yanchep Road (west side included) and its southerly extension to Greenvale Place, south along Greenvale Place (west side included) to Mornington Drive, south along Mornington Drive (west side included) and its southerly extension to Pinjar Road and north along Pinjar Road (east side included) to Joondalup Drive.

The following defines an optional area between Carramar Primary School and Neerabup Primary School—

The locality of Neerabup to the south of Wattle Avenue East and south east of a straight line from the junction of Wattle Avenue East and Hopkins Road to the junction of Wanneroo Road and the road leading to the 10th Light Horse Heritage Walk Trail. The boundary parts of Wattle Avenue East (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The locality of Mariginiup is an optional area for Neerabup Primary School, Spring Hill Primary School, Tapping Primary School and Wanneroo Primary School.

Children of compulsory school age who reside within the local-intake areas of the following secondary schools shall be entitled to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply if there is an appropriate educational program for them at that school. The local-intake area of a secondary school may be defined in this notice by listing the names of the contributory primary schools, the local-intake areas and the traditional catchment areas of which, when amalgamated, constitute the local-intake area of that secondary school. Children who reside outside these local-intake areas may apply to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply.

The following defines an optional area between Belridge Senior High School and Ocean Reef Senior High School—

From the junction of Hodges Drive and Caridean Street, south and east along Caridean Street (east and north sides included) to Roamer Street, north along Roamer Street (both sides included) to Lysander Drive, west along Lysander Drive (both sides included) to Centaur Gardens, north along Centaur Gardens (both sides included) and its northern extension to Hodges Drive and west along Hodges Drive (south side included) to Caridean Street.

The following defines an optional area between Belridge Senior High School, Clarkson Community High School or Kinross College—

From the intersection of Burns Beach Road and Connolly Drive, south along Connolly Drive (east side included) to Moore Drive, east along Moore Drive (north side included) to Joondalup Drive,

north along Joondalup Drive (west side included) to Burns Beach Road and west along Burns Beach Road (south side included) to Connolly Drive.

The following defines an optional area between Belridge Senior High School, Clarkson Community High School, Kinross College or Ocean Reef Senior High School—

From the intersection of Burns Beach Road and Marmion Avenue, south along Marmion Avenue (east side included) to Moore Drive, east along Moore Drive (north side included) to Connolly Drive, north along Connolly Drive (west side included) to Burns Beach Road and west along Burns Beach Road (south side included) to Marmion Avenue.

The following defines an optional area between Belridge Senior High School and Ocean Reef Senior High School—

From the intersection of Marmion Avenue and Shenton Avenue, north along Marmion Avenue (east side included) to Moore Drive, east along Moore Drive (south side included) to Connolly Drive, south along Connolly Drive (west side included) to Shenton Avenue and west along Shenton Drive (north side included) to Marmion Avenue.

The following defines a boundary for an optional area between Belridge Senior High School and Ocean Reef Senior High School—

From the Indian Ocean south of the east-west alignment of Merrifield Place (both sides included), due east to Northshore Drive, north along Northshore Drive (west side included) to Mullaloo Drive, in a general easterly direction along Mullaloo Drive (north side included) to Centaur Street, south along Centaur Street (east side included) to Kallaroo Place, east along Kallaroo Place (north side included) to Marmion Avenue, north along Marmion Avenue (west side included) to Ocean Reef Road, west along Ocean Reef Road (south side included) to the junction with Oceanside Promenade, and due west to the Indian Ocean.

BUTLER SECONDARY SCHOOL (Planning name only—Apr12)

The local-intake area for this school will contain all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools in 2013: Butler, East Butler, Merriwa and Quinns Beach.

From a point on the Mitchell Freeway on the extension of the east-west alignment of Kilkee Street, west from the Freeway along this extension and along the east-west section of Kilkee Street (both sides included) to Sanctuary Gardens, south along Sanctuary Gardens (both sides included) to Ridgewood Boulevard, west along Ridgewood Boulevard (both sides included) to Hinchinbrook Avenue, south and south west along Hinchinbrook Avenue (both sides included) to Connolly Drive, west to Calder Retreat, west along Calder Retreat (both sides included) to Coldstream Circuit, west and north to the northern end of Helby Close (both sides excluded), generally south west between the northern end of Helby Court and the eastern end of Earl Court, south west along Earl Court (both sides included) to Allum Green, south along Allum Green (both sides included) and west between the southern end of Allum Green and the eastern end of Daintree Court (both sides excluded) to the junction of Coldstream Circuit and Sandon Elbow, north along Coldstream Circuit (both sides excluded) to Baltimore Parade, west along Baltimore Parade (north side included) to Tenby Close, west along Tenby Close (both sides excluded) and north west between the western end of Drammen Elbow and northern end of Ronez Elbow, south and west along Ronez Elbow (both sides excluded) to Dunmore Circuit, north along Dunmore Circuit to (both sides excluded) to Avola Cove, west along Avola Cove (both sides excluded) and its extension to Marmion Avenue, north along Marmion Avenue (east side included) to Barbara Parade, west along Barbara Parade (both sides included) to Morialta Avenue, south west along Morialta Avenue (both sides included) to Tapping Way, north west along Tapping Way (north east side included) to the cul-de-sac, continuing north west along the cul-de-sac (east side included) to the shared path, north west along the shared path (east side included) to Camira Way, west along Camira Way (north side included) to Ocean Drive, west to the Indian Ocean coastline and north along the coastline to the boundary between the localities of Alkimos and Eglinton, east along this locality boundary to the proposed alignment of the Mitchell Freeway, south along the proposed alignment of the Mitchell Freeway to a point on the extension of the east-west alignment of Kilkee Street.

The following defines an optional area between Butler Secondary School and Clarkson Community College—

The local-intake area for this school will contain all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools in 2013: Clarkson, Merriwa, Mindarie, Quinns Rocks and Somerly.

The following will define the local-intake area of Clarkson Community High School from 2013—

this extension and along the east-west section of Kilkee Street (both sides excluded) to Sanctuary Gardens, south along Sanctuary Gardens (both sides excluded) to Ridgewood Boulevard, west along Ridgewood Boulevard (both sides excluded) to Hinchinbrook Avenue, south and south west along Hinchinbrook Avenue (both sides excluded) to Connolly Drive, west to Calder Retreat, west along Calder Retreat (both sides excluded) to Coldstream Circuit, west and north to the northern end of Helby Close (both sides included), generally south west between the northern end of Helby Court and the eastern end of Earl Court, south west along Earl Court (both sides excluded) to Allum Green, south along Allum Green (both sides excluded) and west between the southern end of Allum Green and the eastern end of Daintree Court (both sides included) to the junction of Coldstream Circuit and Sandon Elbow, north along Coldstream Circuit (both sides included) to Baltimore Parade, west along Baltimore Parade (south side included) to Tenby Close, west along Tenby Close (both sides included) and north west between the western end of Drammen Elbow and the northern end of Ronez Elbow, south and west along Ronez Elbow (both sides included) to Dunmore Circuit, north along Dunmore Circuit to (both sides included) to Avola Cove, west along Avola Cove (both sides included) and its extension to Marmion Avenue, north along Marmion Avenue (west side included) to Barbara Parade, west along Barbara Parade (both sides excluded) to Morialta Avenue, south west along Morialta Avenue (both sides excluded) to Tapping Way, north west along Tapping Way (south side included) to View Terrace, west along View Terrace (both sides excluded) to Ashley Avenue, south west along Ashley Avenue (both sides excluded) to Terry Road, west along Terry Road (both sides excluded) to Ocean Drive, west to the Indian Ocean coastline and south along the coastline to the locality boundary between Burns and Tamala Park.

The following defines an optional area between Clarkson Community High School and Wanneroo Senior High School—

From a point on the Old Yanchep Road and on the eastern extension of Dogarch Road, west along Dogarch Road (both sides included) to Emerald Drive, south west to the junction of Wanneroo Road and Bernard Road South, south west to the junction of the locality boundaries of Alkimos and Eglinton and the proposed Mitchell Freeway, south east along the proposed Mitchell Freeway to the locality boundary between Clarkson and Tamala Park, east north east from this point to the intersection of Wanneroo Road and Flynn Drive and north, north east and east along Flynn Drive to Pinjar Road. The boundary parts of Flynn Drive (north side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Belridge Senior High School, Clarkson Community High School or Kinross College—

From the intersection of Burns Beach Road and Connolly Drive, south along Connolly Drive to Moore Drive, east along Moore Drive to Joondalup Drive, north along Joondalup Drive to Burns Beach Road and west along Burns Beach Road to Connolly Drive. The boundary parts of Connolly Drive (east side), Moore Drive (north side), Joondalup Drive (west side) and Burns Beach Road (south side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Belridge Senior High School, Clarkson Community High School, Kinross College or Ocean Reef Senior High School—

From the intersection of Burns Beach Road and Marmion Avenue, south along Marmion Avenue to Moore Drive, east along Moore Drive to Connolly Drive, north along Connolly Drive to Burns Beach Road and west along Burns Beach Road to Marmion Avenue. The boundary parts of Marmion Avenue (east side), Moore Drive (north side), Connolly Drive (west side) and Burns Beach Road (south side) are included within this optional area.

COMET BAY COLLEGE (Apr12)

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Baldivis, Comet Bay, Secret Harbour, Makybe Rise, Singleton, Settlers.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Mandurah Road and the locality boundary between Secret Harbour and Port Kennedy, north along Mandurah Road (east side included) to Millar Road, east and north east along Millar Road West (both sides included) to Wellard Road, generally east along the locality boundary of Baldivis to the bridge over the drain near the junction of Mundijong Road and Duckpond Road, south along the drain to a point due north of the junction of Karnup Road and Yangedi Road, south along Yangedi Road (both sides included) to Henderson Road, west along Henderson Road (both sides included) and its westward extension to the Serpentine River, south along the Serpentine River to the southern boundary of the locality of Karnup, west along the southern boundary of the locality of Karnup to Mandurah Road, continuing west across Mandurah Road and along the locality boundary between Madora Bay and Singleton to the Indian Ocean coastline, north along the coastline to a point on the locality boundary between Secret Harbour and Port Kennedy and east along this locality boundary to Mandurah Road.

The following defines an optional area between Comet Bay College and Mandurah High School—

From the coastline of the Indian Ocean, east along the locality boundary between Madora Bay and Singleton to Mandurah Road, south along Mandurah Road (west side included) to a point on the easterly extension of the proposed George Hibbert Road, west from this point on Mandurah Road along the easterly extension of George Hibbert Road, west along George Hibbert Road (both sides excluded), and west along its westerly extension to the coastline and north along the coastline to the locality boundary of Madora Bay and Singleton.

The following defines an optional area between Comet Bay College and Armadale Senior High School—

From the junction of Duckpond Road and Mundijong Road, west along Mundijong Road to the locality boundary between Baldivis and Oldbury, north west along this locality boundary and

continuing east and north east along the locality boundary between Oldbury and Wellard to the railway line, east along the railway line to a drain, south south east along the drain to the Birraga Main Drain, south and south west along the main drain to Mundijong Road and west along Mundijong Road (north side included) to Duckpond Road.

COMET BAY COLLEGE (Apr12)

The local-intake area for this school will contain all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Comet Bay, Secret Harbour and Singleton—from 2013.

The following will define the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Mandurah Road and the locality boundary between Secret Harbour and Port Kennedy, north along Mandurah Road (east side included) to Stakehill Road, east along Stakehill Road (south side included) to the junction of Stakehill Road, Baldivis Road and the locality boundary between Baldivis and Karnup, east along this locality boundary to the Serpentine River, south along the Serpentine River to the southern boundary of the locality of Karnup, west along the southern boundary of the locality of Karnup to Mandurah Road, continuing west across Mandurah Road and along the locality boundary between Madora Bay and Singleton to the Indian Ocean coastline, north along the coastline to a point on the locality boundary between Secret Harbour and Port Kennedy and east along this locality boundary to Mandurah Road.

The following defines an optional area between Comet Bay College and Mandurah High School—

From the coastline of the Indian Ocean, east along the locality boundary between Madora Bay and Singleton to Mandurah Road, south along Mandurah Road (west side included) to a point on the easterly extension of the proposed George Hibbert Road, west from this point on Mandurah Road along the easterly extension of George Hibbert Road, west along George Hibbert Road (both sides excluded), and west along its westerly extension to the coastline and north along the coastline to the locality boundary of Madora Bay and Singleton.

DALYELLUP COLLEGE (Apr12)

Primary Section: Years 1 to 7

The following will define the local-intake area for students in Years 1 to 7 at this school from 2013—

From the junction of Dalyellup Boulevard and Koonak Street, east along Koonak Street (both sides included) to Kambany Approach, south east to the junction of Bussell Highway and Hastie Road, south east and east along Hastie Road (south side included) to Jules Road, south along Jules Road (both sides included) to Lot 155, west along the southern boundary of Lot 156 to Jilley Road, south along Jilley Road (both sides included) to Manea Drive, west and south west along Manea Drive (both sides included) to Calinup Road, west along Calinup Road (both sides included) to Bussell Highway, south west along Bussell Highway (both sides included) past Fishermans Road to the southern boundary of Lot 3, north west along the northern boundary of the National Park and its north west extension to the Indian Ocean, north along the coastline to a point on the western extension of Centenary Road, east along this extension and along Centenary Road (both sides excluded) to a point on the northern extension of Dalyellup Boulevard, south along this extension to the junction of Dalyellup Boulevard and Murtin Road and south along Dalyellup Boulevard (both sides included) to Koonak Street.

Secondary Section : Year 8 and above

From 2013, the local-intake of this school for secondary students will contain the local-intake areas of the following schools offering primary education: Capel Primary School, Dalyellup College, East Dalyellup Primary School.

The following will define the local-intake area for students of secondary school age (Year 8 and above) at this school from 2013—

From a point where the western extension of Centenary Road meets the Indian Ocean coastline, east along this extension and Centenary Road to and across Bussell Highway to Jules Road, south along Jules Road (both sides included) to Lot 155, west along the southern boundary of Lot 156 to Jilley Road, south along Jilley Road (both sides included) to Manea Drive, west and south west along Manea Drive (both sides included) to Calinup Road, west along Calinup Road (both sides included) to Bussell Highway, south west along Bussell Highway (both sides included) to Boyanup Road West, south east along Boyanup Road West (both sides included) to a point on the northern extension of Washers Road, south from Boyanup Road West to the northern most point of Washers Road, continuing south along Washers Road (both sides included) to Gavins Road, east along Gavins Road (both sides included) to Elgin Road, south along Elgin Road (both sides included) and its southern extension to the Capel River, south east along the Capel River to a point due north of the intersection of Goodwood Road and the local government boundary between the Shire of Busselton and the Shire of Capel, generally west along this local government boundary to near the junction of Armstrong Road and Tutunup Road, and north along the local government boundary to the eastern extension of Downes Road, west along this extension and west along Downes Road (north side included) to Colyoolup Road, north along Colyoolup Road (east side included) to Hutton Road, north along Hutton Road (east side included) to Bussell Highway, north west from Bussell Highway through the Tuart Forest National Park to the Indian Ocean coastline, and north east along the coastline to the western extension of Centenary Road.

DUNCRAIG SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Apr12)

From the intersection of Marmion Avenue and Whitfords Avenue, east along Whitfords Avenue (south side included) to the Mitchell Freeway, south along the Mitchell Freeway (west side

included) to Warwick Road, west along Warwick Road (north side included) to Marmion Avenue, south along Marmion Avenue (west side included) to Freeman Way, north west along Freeman Way (north side included) to High Street, west along High Street (north side included) and its western extension to the Indian Ocean coastline, north along the coastline to a point on the western extension of Whitfords Avenue and east along this extension and Whitfords Avenue (south side included) to Marmion Avenue.

JOHN TONKIN COLLEGE (Apr12)

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Greenfields, Mandurah, Meadow Springs, North Mandurah, Riverside and Singleton.

The following defines the local-intake area of John Tonkin College—

From the entry of the Mandurah Estuary into the Indian Ocean, south along the Mandurah Estuary to the 'old' Mandurah Bridge, east along Pinjarra Road to the intersection with Fremantle Road, north along Fremantle Road to Gordon Road, east along Gordon Road to Lakes Road, north and east along Lakes Road to the Serpentine River, north along the Serpentine River to the boundary between the Shires of Murray and Rockingham, west along the Murray-Rockingham and Mandurah-Rockingham Shire boundaries to Fremantle Road, south along Fremantle Road to a point on the easterly extension of the proposed George Hibbert Road, west from this point on Fremantle Road along the easterly extension of George Hibbert Road, west along George Hibbert Road, and west along its westerly extension to the coastline, south along the coastline to the entry of the Mandurah Estuary into the Indian Ocean.

The boundary parts of Pinjarra Road (north side), Fremantle Road (southern section, west side), Gordon Road (north side), Lakes Road (north side), the Murray-Rockingham and Mandurah-Rockingham Shire boundaries (south side), Fremantle Road (northern section, east side) and George Hibbert Road (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of John Tonkin College.

The following defines an optional area between Coodanup Community College and John Tonkin College—

From the intersection of Fremantle Road and Murdoch Drive east along Murdoch Drive to Bortolo Drive, north along Bortolo Drive to Exchequer Avenue, east along Exchequer Avenue to Lakes Road, north along Lakes Road to Gordon Road, west along Gordon Road to Fremantle Road and south along Fremantle Road to Murdoch Drive. The boundary parts of Murdoch Drive (north side), Bortolo Drive (west side), Exchequer Avenue (north side), Lakes Road (west side), Gordon Road (south side) and Fremantle Road (east side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Comet Bay College and John Tonkin College—

From the coastline of the Indian Ocean, east along the locality boundary between Madora Bay and Singleton to Fremantle Road, south along Fremantle Road to a point on the easterly extension of the proposed George Hibbert Road, west from this point on Fremantle Road along the easterly extension of George Hibbert Road, west along George Hibbert Road, and west along its westerly extension to the coastline, north along the coastline to the locality boundary of Madora Bay and Singleton. The boundary parts of Fremantle Road (west side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of George Hibbert Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

Students residing in the localities of Barragup or Furnissdale have the option of attending either Coodanup Community College, John Tonkin College or Pinjarra Senior High School.

KELMSCOTT SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Apr12)

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of Kingsley and Westfield Park Primary Schools and the traditional catchment areas of the following primary schools : Clifton Hills, Grovelands and Kelmscott.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Lake Road with Albany Highway, north along Albany Highway to the road that leads to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre, east along the aforesaid road to the Canning River, south along the Canning River to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, east, south and east along this local government boundary to Canning Mills Road, south west along Canning Mills Road to a point due west of the southern extremity of Coventry Road, east from this point to a point due north of the eastern extremity of Buckingham Road, south from this point through the eastern extremity of Buckingham Road and continuing south through the junction of Brookton Highway and Stocker Road, and continuing south to a point due east of the eastern extension of Salter Road, west along this extension to Salter Road itself, and continuing west, and north along existing and proposed sections of Salter Road to Wahroonga Road, west along Wahroonga Road and its western extension to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Galliers Avenue, west along Galliers Avenue and its extension to Railway Avenue, north along Railway Avenue to Champion Drive, north west along Champion Drive and its extension to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, north east and south east along this local government boundary to the intersection of Lake Road with Albany Highway.

The boundary parts of Albany Highway (northern section, east side), the road to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre (south side), Salter Road (both sides), Wahroonga Road (both sides), Albany Highway (southern section, west side), Galliers Avenue (both sides), Railway Avenue (both sides) and Champion Drive (north east side) are included within the local-intake

area of this school. The boundary parts of Canning Mills Road (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Gosnells and Kelmscott Senior High Schools—

From the junction of Mills Road East and Tonkin Highway, south west along Tonkin Highway to the bridge over the Canning River, south along the Canning River to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, east, south and east along the local government boundary to the western boundary of the Cohunu Wildlife Sanctuary site and continuing north to a point east of the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way, west from this point to the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way and in a generally westerly direction along Mills Road East to the junction with Tonkin Highway.

The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (south east side), Canning Highway (east side), Pages Way (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Kelmscott Senior High School and Roleystone District High School—

From the junction of Chevin Road and Canning Mills Road, east along Chevin Road to a point midway between Coventry Road and Hill Road, south from this point to a point due east of the southern extremity of Coventry Road, west from this point to Canning Mills Road and north east along Canning Mills Road to Chevin Road.

The boundary parts of Chevin Road (both sides) and Canning Mills Road (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Cecil Andrews and Kelmscott Senior High Schools—

From the intersection of Lake Road and Champion Drive, south west along Lake Road to Bay Court, north west along Bay Court and its extension to the Southern River, north along the Southern River to the north westerly extension of Champion Drive, and south east along the extension of Champion Drive to Lake Road.

The boundary parts of Lake Road (west side), and Bay Court (both sides) are included within this optional area.

Students in Years 11 and 12 residing in the localities of Canning Mills (south of Munday Brook), Karragullen, Martin (east of a north-south line on the western boundary of the Black Cockatoo Preservation Society property -previously the Cohunu Wildlife Sanctuary), or Roleystone, have the option of attending either Kelmscott Senior High School or Lesmurdie Senior High School.

LESMURDIE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Apr12)

The local-intake area for this secondary school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following public primary schools: Falls Road, Lesmurdie, Pickering Brook, Walliston and Wattle Grove.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the south western end of Falls Road, generally north east along Falls Road to Lesmurdie Road, north east and east along Lesmurdie Road to Lesmurdie Road East, north east along Lesmurdie Road East to Jackson Road, north east along Jackson Road to the junction of the locality boundaries between Bickley, Kalamunda and Walliston, north and east along the locality boundary between Bickley and Kalamunda to the locality boundary between Bickley and Piesse Brook, generally south east along the locality boundary of Bickley to the junction between the localities of Bickley, Pickering Brook and Reservoir, generally east, south, and west along the locality boundary of Pickering Brook to the junction of the localities of Canning Mills, Karragullen and Pickering Brook, north along the locality boundary between Canning Mills and Pickering Brook to Carinyah Road, north west along Carinyah Road to Munday Brook, north west along Munday Brook to Victoria Reservoir, west through Victoria Reservoir to the south west corner of Victoria Reservoir, south to the local government boundary between the Shire of Kalamunda and the City of Gosnells, in a generally north west direction along this local government boundary to the junction of the localities of Lesmurdie, Orange Grove and Wattle Grove, generally north along the locality boundary between Lesmurdie and Wattle Grove to Welshpool Road East, north east to the western end of Kell Place, and generally north along the locality boundary between Lesmurdie and Forrestfield to the south western end of Falls Road. The boundary parts of Carinyah Road (both sides) and Kell Place (both sides) are included within this local-intake area.

The boundary parts of Falls Road (both sides), Lesmurdie Road (both sides), Lesmurdie Road East (both sides) and Jackson Road (both sides) are optional between Lesmurdie Senior High School and Kalamunda Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Forrestfield Senior High School and Lesmurdie Senior High School—

From the intersection of the Roe Highway and the Tonkin Highway, south along the Roe Highway to Welshpool Road East, east along Welshpool Road East to the railway bridge, south east from the railway bridge along the locality boundary between Kenwick and Wattle Grove, continuing north east and south east along this locality boundary to Boundary Road, north east along the extension of Boundary Road to Tonkin Highway, south east along Tonkin Highway to the local government boundary between the City of Gosnells and the Shire of Kalamunda, north east and then south east along this local government boundary to the locality boundary between Wattle Grove and Lesmurdie, north east, north west and north east along this locality boundary to Welshpool Road East, generally north west along Welshpool Road East to a point due south of the picnic area on Lesmurdie Brook at the south east end of Palm Terrace, north to the picnic area,

north west along Palm Terrace to Lewis Road, south west along Lewis Road to Welshpool Road East, west from this junction through Hartfield Country Club golf course to the Tonkin Highway and north west along Tonkin Highway to Roe Highway.

The boundary parts of Roe Highway (east side), Welshpool Road East (western section, north side), Tonkin Highway (southern section, east side), Welshpool Road East (eastern section, south side), Palm Terrace (both sides) and Tonkin Highway (northern section, west side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Lewis Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

Students in Years 11 and 12 residing in the localities of Canning Mills (south of Munday Brook), Karragullen, Martin (east of a north-south line on the western boundary of the Black Cockatoo Preservation Society property -previously the Cohunu Wildlife Sanctuary), or Roleystone, have the option of attending either Kelmscott Senior High School or Lesmurdie Senior High School.

ROCKINGHAM SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Apr12)

The local-intake area of Rockingham Senior High School contains the following primary schools: Bungaree, Cooloongup, Hillman, and Rockingham Beach.

The following defines the local-intake area for Rockingham Senior High School—

From the coastline, east along Boundary Road (both sides included) to the proposed Garden Island Highway, south east and east along the proposed Garden Island Highway to Rae Road, east and north east along Rae Road (north side included) to Ennis Avenue, south east along Ennis Avenue (east side included) to the most southern point of Link Way (both sides included) east to Mandurah Road, north along Mandurah Road (west side included) to the intersection with Millar Road and the local government boundary between the Town of Kwinana and the City of Rockingham, north and west along this local government boundary to the coastline, south west, west and south along the coastline to Boundary Road.

The following defines an optional area for Rockingham Senior High School and Safety Bay Senior High School—

From the intersection of Rae Road and Read Street, south-southeast along Read Street (east side included) to a point adjacent to the northern arm of Frome Way, in an east-north-easterly direction from this point to and along Frome Way (both sides excluded) to Breden Drive, south along Breden Drive (both sides included) to Norring Street, in an east-north-easterly direction between Raby Court, Lara Court, Greta Court and Rydal Court to the north and Tanby Place, Windale Place and Toora Place to the south to and across Linville Avenue and Wilmott Drive to Grange Drive, continuing in a general north-easterly direction along Grange Drive (north side included) to Ennis Avenue, northwest along Ennis Avenue (west side included) to Rae Road and in a west-south-westerly direction along Rae Road (south side included) to Read Street.

SAFETY BAY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Apr12)

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Charthouse, Cooloongup, East Waikiki, Safety Bay and Waikiki.

The following defines the local-intake area for Safety Bay Senior High School—

From the coastline, east along Boundary Road (both sides included) to the proposed Garden Island Highway, south east and east along the proposed Garden Island Highway to Rae Road, east and north east along Rae Road (south side included) to Read Road, southeast along Read Road (west side included) to a point adjacent to the northern arm of Frome Way, east-north-east from this point to and along Frome Way (both sides included) to Breden Drive, south along Breden Drive (both sides excluded) to Norring Street, in an east-north-easterly direction between Raby Court, Lara Court, Greta Court and Rydal Court to the north, and Tanby Place, Windale Place and Toora Place to the south, to and across Linville Avenue and Wilmott Drive to Grange Drive, continuing in a general north-easterly direction along Grange Drive (south side included) to Ennis Avenue, south east along Ennis Avenue (west side included) to Safety Bay Road, west along Safety Bay Road (north side included) to Hockin Street, south and southwest along Hockin Street (both sides included) and its extension to the coastline and generally north along the coastline to Boundary Road.

The following defines an optional area for Rockingham Senior High School and Safety Bay Senior High School—

From the intersection of Rae Road and Read Street, south-southeast along Read Street (east side included) to a point adjacent to the northern arm of Frome Way, in an east-north-easterly direction from this point to and along Frome Way (both sides excluded) to Breden Drive, south along Breden Drive (both sides included) to Norring Street, in an east-north-easterly direction between Raby Court, Lara Court, Greta Court and Rydal Court to the north and Tanby Place, Windale Place and Toora Place to the south to and across Linville Avenue and Wilmott Drive to Grange Drive, continuing in a general north-easterly direction along Grange Drive (north side included) to Ennis Avenue, northwest along Ennis Avenue (west side included) to Rae Road and in a west-south-westerly direction along Rae Road (south side included) to Read Street.

WANNEROO SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following primary schools are located within the local-intake area of this school: Carramar, East Wanneroo, Hocking, Neerabup, Spring Hill, Tapping and Wanneroo; and Yanchep District High School.

The following will define the local-intake area for Wanneroo Senior High School from 2013—

From the intersection of Flynn Drive and Old Yanchep Road, generally west along Flynn Drive to Wanneroo Road, west south west to the proposed alignment of the Mitchell Freeway at the

intersection of the localities of Clarkson and Tamala Park, south along the proposed Mitchell Freeway to Burns Beach Road, east along Burns Beach Road and east along Joondalup Drive to the locality boundary between Joondalup and Wanneroo, south along the locality boundary between Joondalup and Wanneroo to the shoreline of Lake Joondalup, generally south along the western shore of Lake Joondalup to Ocean Reef Road, east along Ocean Reef Road to Wanneroo Road and continuing east along Ocean Reef Road and the proposed alignment of Ocean Reef Road to the locality boundary between Gnangara and Wanneroo (at Badgerup Road), north and east along this locality boundary to the local government boundary between the City of Wanneroo and the City of Swan, north along this boundary to Neaves Road, south west and west along Neaves Road to Old Yancheop Road and north along Old Yancheop Road to Flynn Drive.

The boundary parts of Flynn Drive (south side), Burns Beach Road (north side), Ocean Reef Road (north side), Neaves Road (both sides) and Old Yancheop Road (both sides) are included within the local-intake area for Wanneroo Senior High School.

Students residing within the locality of Gnangara have the option of attending either Ashdale Secondary College or Wanneroo Senior High School.

The following will define an optional area for students in the secondary year levels from 2013 between Butler Secondary School, Wanneroo Senior High School and Yancheop District High School—

The localities of Eglinton, Two Rocks and Yancheop, and the area of the locality of Carabooda located to the north of the following boundary—

From the intersection of the proposed alignment of the Mitchell Freeway and the locality boundary between Alkimos and Eglinton, north east to the junction of Wanneroo Road and Bernard Road South, north east to the junction of Emerald Drive and Dogarch Road, east along Dogarch Road (both sides included) and its easterly extension to Old Yancheop Road.

The following defines an optional area between Clarkson Community High School and Wanneroo Senior High School—

From a point on the Old Yancheop Road and on the eastern extension of Dogarch Road, west along Dogarch Road (both sides included) to Emerald Drive, south west to the junction of Wanneroo Road and Bernard Road South, south west to the junction of the locality boundaries of Alkimos and Eglinton and the proposed Mitchell Freeway, south east along the proposed Mitchell Freeway to the locality boundary between Clarkson and Tamala Park, east north east from this point to the intersection of Wanneroo Road and Flynn Drive and north, north east and east along Flynn Drive to Pinjar Road. The boundary parts of Flynn Drive (north side) are included within this optional area.

WARNBRO COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL (Apr12)

The following defines the local-intake area for Warnbro Community High School—

From a point on both the coastline and the western extension of Hockin Street, east along this extension to Hockin Street, north east along Hocking Street (both sides excluded) to Safety Bay Road, east along Safety Bay Road (south side included) to Ennis Avenue, south along Ennis Avenue (both sides included) to Port Kennedy Drive, south west, west and north west along Port Kennedy Drive (both sides included) to the coast line and generally north along the coastline to the western extension of Hockin Street.

From the intersection of the proposed alignment of the Mitchell Freeway and the locality boundary between Alkimos and Eglinton, north east to the junction of Wanneroo Road and Bernard Road South, north east to the junction of Emerald Drive and Dogarch Road, east along Dogarch Road (both sides included) and its easterly extension to Old Yancheop Road.
