BUSH FIRES ACT 1954

Shire of Augusta-Margaret River FIREBREAK NOTICE

In accordance with Section 33 of the Bush Fires Act 1954, you are required to carry out fire prevention work on land owned or occupied by you in accordance with the provisions of this order.

The penalty for non-compliance with this notice is a maximum of \$5000, and not withstanding prosecution, Council may enter upon the land and carry out required works at the owners/occupiers expense.

It is the landowners' responsibility to ensure their property is compliant throughout the maintenance period. Failure to do so may result in an on-the-spot fine of \$250.

- 2. 2 metre mineral earth firebreak inside all boundaries;
- 3. 1 metre horizontal and 4 metre vertical clearance around all dwellings and outbuildings;
- 4. Building Protection Zone of 5 metres around all dwellings, free from garden beds, shrubs, plants and grasses;
- 5. Building Protection Zone 5-20 metres around all dwellings, hazardous material to be removed excluding living plans and trees;
- Hazard Separation Zone, low fuel area of up to 5cm in depth to 100 metres between buildings and / or hazards;
- 7. Ungrazed pastureland to be slashed or mowed and maintained below 10cm;
- 8. 2 metre clearance required around all piles of garden refuse or wood;
- 9. 2 metres firebreak not closer than 6 metres around haystacks and immediately around fuel storage tanks or gas cylinders.

VINEYARDS AND PLANTATIONS (Including Vineyard Tourist Chalets)

Compliance Date: 22 December 2012 to 12 May 2013

- 1. Properties to comply with approved Fire Management Plans, approved Variation to Firebreak and Fuel Hazard Reduction and Firebreak Notice 2012-13;
- 2. 1 metre horizontal and 4 metre vertical clearance around all dwellings and outbuildings;
- 3. Building Protection Zone of 5 metres around all dwellings, free from garden beds, shrubs, plants and grasses;
- 4. Building Protection Zone 5-20 metres around all dwellings, hazardous material to be removed excluding living plans and trees;
- 5. Hazard Separation Zone, low fuel area of up to 5cm in depth to 100 metres between buildings and / or hazards;
- 6. 5 metre wide mineral earth firebreak around vineyards and 10 metre wide mineral earth firebreak round plantations;
- 7. 2 metre mineral earth firebreak within 100 metres of a boundary abutting a road reserve;
- 8. 2 metre clearance require around all piles of garden refuse or wood.

DEFINITIONS

Firebreak

Means a strip of land that has been cleared of all trees, bushes, grasses and any other object or thing or flammable material leaving clear bare mineral earth 2 metres wide and 4 metres vertical clearance. This includes trimming back of all overhanging trees, bushes, shrubs and any other object or thing over the firebreak area.

Firebreaks may have to be reinstalled several times in one year.

Hazard Separation Zone

A Hazard Separation Zone maybe provided between extreme bush fire hazards and buildings to create a minimum separation distance of up to 100 metres if land is available between the buildings and the hazard in order to protect them from burning debris (spotting, airborne embers), radiant heat and direct flame contact.

Building Protection Zone (BPZ)

Means a low fuel area immediately surrounding a dwelling / outbuilding and is designed to minimise the likelihood of flame contact with buildings. BPZ's must be a minimum of 20 metres on flat land with the zone increasing as the slope increases.

BUSHFIRE PRECAUTIONS

Restricted Burning Period: The 'restricted burning' periods that apply within the Shire are—9 November 2012 to 21 December 2012/1 March 2012 to 12 May 2013

Prohibited Burning Period: The 'prohibited burning' period that applies within the Shire is—22 December 2012 to 28 February 2013

These dates may be subject to variation according to seasonal conditions, but any changes will be advertised locally.
