DANGEROUS GOODS SAFETY (ROAD AND RAIL TRANSPORT OF NON-EXPLOSIVES) REGULATIONS 2007

DANGEROUS GOODS SAFETY (ROAD AND RAIL TRANSPORT OF NON-EXPLOSIVES)
DETERMINATION (No. 3) 2012

Legislation

This determination is made by the Chief Dangerous Goods Officer under Regulation 17(1) of the Dangerous Goods Safety (Road and Rail Transport of Non-Explosives) Regulations 2007. The equivalent provision in the Model Subordinate Law from the National Transport Commission is Regulation 1.6.1(1).

The 42nd meeting of the Competent Authorities Panel (CAP) agreed out of session for this determination to have national effect for land transport. This determination remains valid until UN 3489 and UN 3488 are included in the Dangerous Goods List of the Australian Code for the Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail, seventh edition (ADG7).

Determination details

Liquid dangerous goods which meet the classification criteria of UN Recommendations on the Transport of Dangerous Goods Model Regulations Seventeenth (UN 17th) edition for—

- Toxic by inhalation liquids of Packing Group (PG) I,
- Flammable liquids of any PG,
- Corrosive substances of a PG number that is equal to or of higher number than the PG of the flammable liquid (for example: if class 3 is PGII, then class 8 is PGII or PGIII)

are determined to be assigned to Division 6.1 with a primary subsidiary risk of Class 3 and a secondary subsidiary risk of Class 8.

Conditions

It is a condition of this determination that these dangerous goods are transported as classified in accordance with the UN 17th edition—

- \bullet "UN 3489 TOXIC BY INHALATION LIQUID, FLAMMABLE, CORROSIVE, N.O.S. with an inhalation toxicity lower than or equal to 1000 mL/m³ and saturated vapour concentration greater than or equal to 10 LC50" or
- "UN 3488 TOXIC BY INHALATION LIQUID, FLAMMABLE, CORROSIVE, N.O.S. with an inhalation toxicity lower than or equal to 200 mL/m³ and saturated vapour concentration greater than or equal to 500 LC50".

Packing Instructions P602 and P601 from ADG 7 apply to UN 3489 and UN 3488 respectively and the proper shipping name needs to be supplemented by the technical name in accordance with special provision SP274.

Town Planning Scheme No. 4—Amendment No. 19

Ref: TPS/0892

It is hereby notified for public information, in accordance with section 87 of the $Planning\ and\ Development\ Act\ 2005$ that the Minister for Planning approved the City of Subiaco local planning scheme amendment on 18 December 2012 for the purpose of—

- 1. Deleting Clause 70(7)(a) of the Scheme to remove the restriction on the granting of concessions for parking by Council under Clause 28.
- 2. Deleting Clause 70(7)(b) and (c).
- 3. Inserting a new Clause 70(8) as follows—

"70(8) In determining the extent (if any) of the concession in car parking requirements for a proposed non-residential development, the Council is to be satisfied that the lesser

car parking is reasonable taking into consideration the matters set out in clause 28 and the following matters—

- (i) Whether a demand for car parking associated with the proposed development which is less than the requirement in Table 2 has been demonstrated; and
- (ii) The availability and likely use of modes of transport other than the private car; and
- (iii) The practicability and likelihood that car pooling will be employed, as a means of reducing the demand for parking; and
- (iv) The availability and likely level of use of end-of-trip bicycle facilities; and
- (v) The availability of public car parking in the locality including street parking; and
- (vi) Any reduction in car parking demand due to the joint use of car spaces; and
- (vii) Any car parking deficiency or surplus associated with the existing use of the land; and
- (viii) Any other relevant consideration."
- 4 Inserting a new Clause 70(9) as follows—

"Before making a determination under Clause 70(8), the Council may require the applicant to provide, at the applicant's expense, a traffic or transport study prepared by a suitably qualified and experienced transport planner or engineer and shall give due regard to the recommendations of such a report."

5. Deleting Clause 73(3).
