



Prisons Act 1981

Prisons (Hakea Prison) Order (No. 3) 2013

Made by the Minister under the *Prisons Act 1981* section 5.

1. Citation

This order is the *Prisons (Hakea Prison) Order (No. 3) 2013*.

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation on the day on which it is published in the *Gazette*.

3. Prison declared

The buildings and enclosures on Reserve 50756, being Lot 501 on Deposited Plan 69593 (held by the Western Australian Land Information Authority established by the *Land Information Authority Act 2006*), other than those parts of them known as Units 11 and 12, are declared to be a prison, called the Hakea Prison, within the meaning and for the purposes of the Act.

4. Order revoked

The *Prisons (Hakea Prison) Order (No. 2) 2013* is revoked.

Young Offenders Act 1994

**Young Offenders (Detention Centre) Order
(No. 3) 2013**

Made by the Minister under the *Young Offenders Act 1994* section 13.

1. Citation

This order is the *Young Offenders (Detention Centre) Order (No. 3) 2013*.

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation as follows —

- (a) if it is published in the *Gazette* before or on the day on which the *Prisons (Hakea Prison) Order (No. 3) 2013* clause 3 comes into operation — immediately after that clause comes into operation;
- (b) if it is published in the *Gazette* on a day after the day on which the *Prisons (Hakea Prison) Order (No. 3) 2013* clause 3 comes into operation — on the day on which it is published in the *Gazette*.

3. Detention centre declared

Those parts of the buildings and enclosures on Reserve 50756, being Lot 501 on Deposited Plan 69593 (held by the Western Australian Land Information Authority established by the *Land Information Authority Act 2006*) known as Units 11 and 12 of the Hakea Prison, but not being parts of a prison under the *Prisons Act 1981*, are declared to be a detention centre.

4. Previous order revoked

The *Young Offenders (Detention Centre) Order (No. 2) 2013* is revoked.
