Hospitals and Health Services Act 1927

Hospitals (Services Charges) Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 2013

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Hospitals* (Services Charges) Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 2013.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Hospitals* (Services Charges) *Regulations* 1984.

4. **Regulation 4 amended**

In regulation 4(1) delete the definition of *surgically implanted prostheses* and insert:

surgically implanted prostheses —

- (a) means the prostheses specified in the Schedule to the *Private Health Insurance (Prostheses) Rules 2012 (No.2)* (Commonwealth) as in force on the day on which the *Hospitals (Services Charges) Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 2013* regulation 4 comes into operation; but
- (b) does not include a prosthesis supplied to an eligible war service veteran for the purposes of

cardiothoracic surgical service specified in a determination made under section 37(3)(af) of the Act and regulation 5(2)(b);

Hospitals and Health Services Act 1927

Hospitals (Services Charges) Regulations 1984

Hospitals (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Determination 2013

Made by the Minister for Health.

1. Citation

This determination is the Hospitals (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Determination 2013.

2. Commencement

This determination comes into operation as follows —

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 on the day on which this determination is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the determination on the day on which the Hospitals (Services Charges) Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 2013 regulation 4 comes into operation.

3. Application

This determination applies —

(a) to all public hospitals other than day hospitals, nursing homes and nursing posts; and

- (b) with respect to the following
 - (i) private in-patients;
 - (ii) compensable in-patients;
 - (iii) ineligible in-patients;
 - (iv) private same day patients;
 - (v) compensable same day patients;
 - (vi) ineligible same day patients.

4. Charges for surgically implanted prostheses (r. 5(2)(c))

(1) In this clause —

listed amount, in relation to a surgically implanted prosthesis, means the amount specified for that prosthesis in the Prostheses List in the column under the heading "Minimum Benefit";

Prostheses List means the Schedule to the *Private Health Insurance (Prostheses) Rules 2012 (No. 2)* (Commonwealth) as in force on the day on which the *Hospitals (Services Charges) Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 2013* regulation 4 comes into operation.

- (2) The charge payable in respect of the supply of a surgically implanted prosthesis specified in the Prostheses List under the heading "CARDIO THORACIC" is 92.5% of the listed amount.
- (3) The charge payable in respect of the supply of a surgically implanted prosthesis specified in the Prostheses List under the heading "OPHTHALMIC" is 80% of the listed amount.
- (4) The charge payable in respect of the supply of a surgically implanted prosthesis not mentioned in subclause (2) or (3) but otherwise specified in the Prostheses List is the listed amount.

5. Hospitals (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Determination 2006 revoked

The Hospitals (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Determination 2006 is revoked.

GAS STANDARDS ACT 1972

GAS STANDARDS (GAS APPLIANCES) ORDER 2013

Made by the Director of Energy Safety under section 13H of the Act.

1. Citation

This order is the Gas Standards (Gas Appliances) Order 2013.

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation on the day on which this order is published in the Gazette.

3. Terms used

In this order unless the contrary intention appears-

- changed gas has the same meaning as lower heating value gas in section 22 of the Gas Supply (Gas Quality Specifications) Act 2009;
- **Coastal Supply Area** means the area constituted as the coastal supply area by the *Energy Coordination (Coastal Supply Area) Order 2000* under section 11A of the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*;
- **consumer** has the same meaning as in section 22 of the Gas Supply (Gas Quality Specifications) Act 2009; and
- **Gas Appliance Rectification Programme** means the rectification programme established and implemented under section 23 of the *Gas Supply (Gas Quality Specifications) Act 2009.*

4. Class of gas appliance to which this order applies

This order applies to those gas appliances manufactured before 1980 that consume gas supplied to a consumer through a connection point to a distribution system.

5. Gas appliance not to be sold, hired or used

In the Coastal Supply Area, the sale, hire or use of a gas appliance to which this order applies is prohibited unless—

- (i) the gas appliance was registered with the Gas Appliance Rectification Programme and a letter was provided to the consumer that states the gas appliance is safe to operate on the changed gas; or
- (ii) following a request under clause 6, a letter is provided by the Director to the consumer that states the gas appliance is safe to operate on the changed gas.

6. Request to continue use of gas appliance

If a consumer or a gasfitter is of the opinion that a gas appliance to which this order applies will not be unsafe or dangerous in use on changed gas, the consumer or gasfitter may request the Director, in writing, to determine whether the gas appliance is of a kind registered with the Gas Appliance Rectification Programme as being safe to operate on changed gas.
