

- the use of the blue light has been authorised by an officer of the Western Australia Police. Exceptions to this condition are only ever permitted when extraordinary circumstances inhibit the gaining of the authorisation in a timely manner. In these circumstances authorisation must still be gained as soon as is practicable.

Pursuant to regulation 19H(2)(b), the person driving a vessel listed in Schedule 1 is exempt from the following provisions of the regulations—

- Regulation 19A, Speed limit in Swan and Canning Rivers
- Regulation 48, Limitation of speed

Pursuant to section 115A of the Western Australian Marine Act 1982 ("the Act") the person driving a vessel listed in Schedule 1 is also exempt from the provisions of the following sections of the Act—

- Section 66, Closure of navigable waters
- Section 67, Limiting speed of vessels
