## Public Firewood Areas Order (No. 2) 2013

Made by the CEO under the *Forest Management Regulations 1993* regulation 98.

#### 1. Citation

This order is the *Public Firewood Areas Order (No. 2) 2013*.

#### 2. Commencement

This order comes into operation as follows —

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the order on the day after that day.

#### 3. Public firewood areas

- (1) The areas of State forest named in Schedule 1 column 1 and described in Schedule 1 column 3 are
  - (a) set aside for the purposes of the collection of firewood by members of the public; and
  - (b) designated as being areas to which the *Forest Management Regulations 1993* regulation 100 applies.
- (2) The locations of the areas referred to in subclause (1) are shown on the relevant DECMAP referred to in Schedule 1 column 2.

Note: Copies of the DECMAP referred to in Schedule 1 column 2 are available for inspection by the public during normal office hours at the Department of Parks and Wildlife's offices as follows —

#### BIOSECURITY AND AGRICULTURE MANAGEMENT ACT 2007

BIOSECURITY AND AGRICULTURE MANAGEMENT (FRUIT FLY)
MANAGEMENT PLAN 2013

Issued by the Minister under section 45 of the Act.

#### 1. Citation

This management plan is the Biosecurity and Agriculture Management (Fruit Fly) Management Plan 2013

#### 2. Commencement

This management plan comes into operation as follows—

- (a) clauses 1 and 2—on the day on which this management plan is published in the Gazette;
- (b) the rest of the management plan—on the day after that day.

#### 3. Terms used

"relevant land" means land in an area described or set out in clause 4;

"Fruit fly" means Ceratitis capitata;

"appropriate insecticide" means an insecticide registered by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority for the control of fruit fly.

#### 4. Area to which management plan relates

This management plan relates to the areas of the State comprised within the local government districts of the shires of Swan, Mundaring, Kalamunda, Gosnells, Armadale and Serpentine/Jarrahdale

#### 5. Purpose of management plan

The purpose of this management plan is to provide for the control of Fruit fly in each area to which this management plan relates.

#### 6. Measures to be followed under management plan

The owner or occupier of land in the relevant area on which fruit trees are growing must take the following control measures—

- (a) Once in every 48 hours all fruit that is infested with fruit fly must be picked from each fruit tree and treated or destroyed using one of the methods listed below—
  - (i) Mulching to a pulp consistency
  - (ii) Boiling
  - (iii) Spraying with an appropriate insecticide
  - (iv) Solarisation by placing in a sealed plastic bag or equivalent container placed in direct sunlight for at least 7 days
  - (v) Placing in water in a container with a film of kerosene or oil for at least 7 days
  - (vi) Burial to a depth of at least 1 metres
  - (vii) Freezing for 24 hours
- (b) Once in every 48 hours all fallen fruit, whether infested or not, must be either treated on the ground by mulching to a pulp consistency or spraying with an appropriate insecticide or be gathered from the ground and immediately treated or destroyed using one of the methods listed in paragraph (a).

Note: A person who fails to comply with this clause commits an offence under section 30 (3) of the Act. Date: 28 October 2013.

It is hereby notified for public information, in accordance with section 87 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* that the Minister for Planning approved the Shire of Denmark local planning scheme amendment on 21 October 2013 for the purpose of—

- 1. Rezoning Lots 632, 22 and 1 Mount Shadforth Road and Part Lot 355 Warham Road together with the redundant, un-made sections of road reserves dividing Lot 22 and south of Lot 632, Denmark from the 'Rural' zone and no zone to the 'Special Residential' zone.
- 2. Amending Appendix XIV—Special Residential Zone Provisions Relating to Specified Areas, by including Special Residential Zone Area No. 15 as follows—

		(v) If boundary fencing is utilised, it shall be of rural construction such as pine posts/steel posts and strand to the satisfaction of Council.
		(vi) On-site effluent disposal shall be the responsibility of the individual landowner and shall involve the use of on-site disposal systems approved by Council in accordance with Health Department of WA regulations and guidelines.
		(vii) Council shall request the WAPC to impose conditions at the subdivision stage requiring the subdivider to advise prospective purchasers of the land of the following—
		<ul> <li>fire management guidelines and responsibilities; and</li> <li>that sewer is not available.</li> </ul>
		(viii) Council shall request the WAPC to impose a condition at the time of subdivision for additional tree/shrub planting for screening purposes along Mount Shadforth Road.
		(ix) Council shall request the WAPC impose a condition at the time of subdivision for Warham Road to be upgraded to the satisfaction of Council.
		(x) All lots shall be connected to the WA Water Authority reticulated water supply scheme.
		(xi) Council shall request the WAPC to impose conditions at the subdivision stage requiring the preparation of a Fire Management Plan and the implementation of the specific fire protection measures as set out in such a plan.
		(xii) Council shall require all buildings to be designed and constructed in accordance with the construction requirements of Australian Standard 3959—Construction of Buildings in Bushfire Prone Areas for the determined BAL.
