Hospitals (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Amendment Determination (No. 2) 2014

Made by the Minister for Health.

1. Citation

This determination is the *Hospitals* (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Amendment Determination (No. 2) 2014.

2. Commencement

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 on the day on which this determination is published in the *Gazette*;

3. Determination amended

This determination amends the *Hospitals* (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Determination 2013.

4. Clause 4 amended

In clause 4(1) delete the definition of *Prostheses List* and insert:

Prostheses List means the Schedule to the *Private* Health Insurance (Prostheses) Rules 2014 (No. 2) (Commonwealth) as in force on the day on which the Hospitals (Services Charges for the Supply of Surgically Implanted Prostheses) Amendment Determination (No. 2) 2014 clause 4 comes into operation.

BUSH FIRES ACT 1954

City of Bunbury

BUSH FIRE NOTICE AND REQUIREMENTS

Owners or occupiers of land within the City of Bunbury are notified they must comply with the *Bush Fires Act 1954* (the Act) and carry out annual fire-prevention work, as set out in this notice.

All properties within Bunbury are subject to loss due to embers from nearby fires landing within your yards. Most homes are lost through fires from ember attack.

It is an offence not to comply with the Act which carries a modified penalty of \$250 and a maximum penalty of \$5,000. With or without prosecution and in accordance with the Act, the City of Bunbury may enter the land and carry out the required work at the expense of the land owner/occupier.

Work must be completed no later than 30 November and kept maintained throughout the summer months until 10 May annually. Properties assessed as having a bushfire hazard rating of Very High or Extreme will be sent further information and suggested fire-protection strategies.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Private property (including residential, commercial and industrial)

- Where the area of land is 2024m² or less, all flammable material on the land is to be removed except living trees.
- Where the land area exceeds 2024m² provide a 3 metre firebreak free of all flammable material, immediately inside all boundaries and surrounding all buildings and haystacks. Where adjoining lots are held or used by the owner/occupier, firebreaks may be provided immediately inside the external boundaries of the group or lots. Total removal of flammable material from the property would be considered an acceptable alternative.

2. Fuel and gas depots

All flammable material must be cleared from land where there are containers used for liquid or gasfuel storage including clearing all flammable material from any liquid or gas-fuel storage ramps or supports.

3. Plantations

Firebreaks 15 metres wide must be provided immediately adjoining all external boundaries of the planted area. The outer 10 metres must be cleared of all flammable material. The inner 5 metres, closest to the trees may be kept in a reduced fuel state by slashing or used for grazing provided the height of grass does not exceed 8cm. Plantations must be subdivided into areas not exceeding 30 hectares by firebreaks 6 metres wide. Firebreaks must be cleared of all flammable material and in the vertical plane a minimum height clearance of 5 metres from the ground level will be maintained above the firebreak.

4. Prohibited and restricted burning

The Prohibited Burning Period in the City of Bunbury district is from 30 December to 28 March annually. The Restricted Burning Periods in the City of Bunbury district are from 15 November to 29 December and from 29 March to 10 May annually. These dates may be varied according to seasonal conditions, but any changes will be publicly advertised.

5. Burning permits—bush, grass and garden refuse

Permits are required for any burning including garden refuse during the Restricted Burning Period as above. Burning of anything including bush, grass and garden refuse is totally prohibited from 30 December to 28 March annually. Burning permits will only be issued to owner/occupiers of land for hazard reduction burning until 30 November annually.

6. Campfires

Campfires are completely banned in the City of Bunbury from 15 November to 10 May annually.

7. Exemptions

If it is impractical to clear firebreaks as required by this notice or if natural features make firebreaks unnecessary, you may apply to the Council or its authorised officer until 15 November for permission to provide firebreaks in alternative positions or take other action to abate fire hazards. If permission is not granted the requirements of the notice must be complied with.

BUSH FIRES ACT 1954

City of Stirling

FIREBREAK NOTICE

All land owners and occupiers are required to install firebreaks by 30 November 2014 or within 14 days of becoming the owner or occupier of the land.

This is necessary to—

- help prevent the spread of fire
- allow easy access for emergency
- provide a break from which back burning can take place.

The firebreak must be maintained up to and including 31 March 2015 and must be-

- clear of all combustible materials;
- a minimum width of three metres immediately inside all external boundaries of the land; and
- a minimum width of three metres surrounding all buildings on the land.

Rangers will conduct firebreak inspections from 1 December 2014. Where a firebreak is not installed by this date, an on the spot fine of \$250.00 will be issued to the owner, and the City will organise for a contractor to install the firebreak and recover the costs from the owner.

Backyard burning and the use of incinerators are prohibited within the City of Stirling at all times.

If the owner or occupier believes it is impractical to clear a firebreak they must apply in writing to the City of Stirling before Friday 8 November 2014.

WATER SERVICES ACT 2012

EXEMPTION NOTICE

Exemption for the City of Fremantle for a water service on Lot 2089 Stevens Street, White Gum Valley

In accordance with section 7 of the *Water Services Act 2012*, the Hon Mia Davies MLA, Minister for Water, granted an exemption from the application of section 5(1) of the Act to the City of Fremantle on 6 October 2014, in respect of the provision of a water service on Lot 2089 Stevens Street, White Gum Valley.

The water service is a non-potable water supply service provided as a community bore scheme for the residents of an infill urban development. Water is sourced from a community bore on the site and used to water public open space and residential gardens.

The exemption is valid for an indefinite period.

Summary of the reasons for the decision

Granting this exemption is not contrary to the public interest. It is considered that—

- the regulatory burden imposed by licensing would be disproportionately high given the small scale of the service;
- the risks of the abuse of monopoly power are low. The service is operated on a not-for-profit basis; and
- the public health aspects of the service are regulated under the *Health Act 1911*.
