Local Government (Beverley - Discontinuance of Ward System) Order 2015

1. Citation

This order is the *Local Government (Beverley - Discontinuance of Ward System) Order 2015.*

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation as follows —

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the order on the day after that day.

3. Terms used

In this order —

commencement day means the day on which the rest of the order comes into operation under clause 2(b);

next election means the first ordinary election for the Shire of Beverley held after commencement day;

next election day means the day fixed for the holding of the poll for the next election.

4. Abolition of wards (s. 2.2(1)(d) of the Act)

All wards in the district of Beverley are abolished immediately before next election day.

5. Consequential directions (s. 9.62 of the Act)

In order to give effect to clause 4 —

- (a) Part 4 of the Act applies to preparing for and conducting the next election as if the changes effected by clause 4 take effect on commencement day; and
- (b) the operation of Part 4 of the Act is modified to the extent necessary for the purposes of paragraph (a).

RACING AND WAGERING WESTERN AUSTRALIA ACT 2003

RWWA RULES OF GREYHOUND RACING 2008

In accordance with Section 45 (1) (c) of the Racing and Wagering Western Australia Act 2003, notice is hereby given that the Board of Racing and Wagering WA on 19th February 2015 resolved to amend the RWWA Rules of Greyhound Racing 2008 as follows—

Amendment to Local Rules

Amend Local Rule 86B.

LR86B Offence to use live game

- (1) A person who—
 - (a) uses in connection with greyhound racing or training any species of bird or animal which is alive, whether as a lure or to excite a greyhound, or
 - (b) brings onto or has in their possession on any grounds or within the boundaries of any property where greyhounds are, or are to be, trained, kept or raced any species of bird or animal which might reasonably be capable of being used as a lure or to excite a greyhound; or
 - (c) allows a greyhound for the purpose of training to pursue or attack any live bird or animal; or
 - (d) is convicted in a Court for the use of or having a live bird or animal for any purpose connected with greyhound racing;

shall be disqualified for a period of not less than ten (10) years and shall also be fined not less than \$50,000.

- (2) Where an offence contrary to this rule occurs on any ground under the control or management of the licensee or manager of a greyhound trial track the registration of the track and of any person concerned with the management of that track may be cancelled, either for a specified period or permanently, and any such person may be penalised in accordance with these Rules.
- (3) Any person penalised in relation to this rule, shall not be entitled to make any future applications for licence to the Controlling Body or to be an owner of any registered greyhound.
- (4) It shall be a defence to a charge pursuant to LR86B(1)(b) for the person to prove that the possession of the bird or animal is as a domestic pet.
