# DANGEROUS GOODS SAFETY (ROAD AND RAIL TRANSPORT OF NON-EXPLOSIVES) REGULATIONS 2007

DANGEROUS GOODS SAFETY (ROAD AND RAIL TRANSPORT OF NON-EXPLOSIVES)
DETERMINATION (No. 3) 2015

This determination is made by the Chief Dangerous Goods Officer under Regulation 19 (f) of the Dangerous Goods Safety (Road and Rail Transport of Non-Explosives) Regulations 2007. The equivalent provision in the Model Subordinate Law from the National Transport Commission is Regulation 1.6.3 (f).

This determination—

- applies to consignors, prime contractors, loaders and drivers involved in the transport of IBCs containing UN 3342—xanthates regardless of the Packing Group (the particular dangerous goods):
- requires that those IBCs, other than metal or rigid plastic IBCs, must be transported within closed cargo transport units (the specified packaging).

This determination has been given national effect for land transport by the decision of CAP on 11 November 2015 with the CAP-assigned number DET 2015/203.
