Sandalwood Act 1929

# Sandalwood (Limitation of Removal of Sandalwood) Order 2015

Made by the Governor in Executive Council under section 2 of the *Sandalwood Act 1929*.

## 1. Citation

This order may be cited as the Sandalwood (Limitation of Removal of Sandalwood) Order 2015.

### 2. Limitation

- (1) The quantity of wild sandalwood that may be pulled or removed from Crown land and alienated land during each period to which this sub-clause applies is limited to a total of 2,500 tonnes, comprising
  - (a) a maximum of 1,250 tonnes of green sandalwood; and
  - (b) a minimum of 1,250 tonnes of dead sandalwood.
- (2) The quantity of sandalwood includes all parts of the tree except leaves, bark and small branches (less than 25 millimetres diameter at the large end under bark).
- (3) Subclauses (1) and (2) apply to the period commencing on 1 July 2016 and ending on 30 June 2026.

## 3. 1996 order repealed

The Sandalwood (Limitation of Removal of Sandalwood) Order 1996\* is repealed on 30 June 2016.

# Sandalwood (Limitation on Removal of Sandalwood) Order (No. 2) 2015

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

#### 1. Citation

This order is the Sandalwood (Limitation on Removal of Sandalwood) Order (No. 2) 2015.

### 2. Commencement

This order comes into operation immediately after the Sandalwood (Limitation of Removal of Sandalwood) Order 2015 comes into operation.

# 3. Limitation on quantity of sandalwood

(1) In this clause —

*relevant half year* means the period beginning on 1 July 2026 and ending on 31 December 2026;

*relevant year* means each year beginning on 1 July during the period beginning on 1 July 2016 and ending on 30 June 2026.

- (2) The quantity of sandalwood that may be pulled or removed from Crown land and alienated land during a relevant year is limited to a total of 2 500 tonnes, of which no more than 1 250 tonnes may be living sandalwood.
- (3) The quantity of sandalwood that may be pulled or removed from Crown land and alienated land during the relevant half year is limited to a total of 1 250 tonnes, of which no more than 625 tonnes may be living sandalwood.
- (4) Subclauses (2) and (3) do not apply to sandalwood grown on a plantation.
- (5) In calculating the number of tonnes for the purpose of subclause (2) or (3), the following is not to be included
  - (a) leaves;
  - (b) bark;
  - (c) branches that have a diameter of less than 25 millimetres at the larger end, when stripped of bark.

## 4. Orders repealed

- (1) The Sandalwood (Limitation of Removal of Sandalwood) Order 2015 is repealed.
- (2) The Sandalwood (Limitation of Removal of Sandalwood) Order 1996 is repealed at the end of 30 June 2016.
