Port Beach—Hillarys: within 200 metres of the foreshore commencing at the southern limit of Port Beach, Fremantle and extending northwards along the coast to a line between 31°49.604'S, 115°44.190'E and 31°49.671'S, 115°44.060'E (corresponding to the southern boundary of the Boyinaboat Reef dive area);
