This notice comes into operation on the day in which it is published in the Government Gazette.


#### 3. Inclusion of additional waters in Yawuru Nagulagun / Roebuck Bay Marine Park

The boundaries of the Yawuru Nagulagun / Roebuck Bay Marine Park are altered to include additional waters so that the Yawuru Nagulagun / Roebuck Bay Marine Park comprises the part of Western Australian waters described in Schedule 1.

### 4. Yawuru Nagulagun / Roebuck Bay Marine Park reserved and classified

- (1) The area described in Schedule 1 is reserved as a marine park, to be known as the Yawuru Nagulagun / Roebuck Bay Marine Park, and classified as Class A.
- (2) The area described in Schedule 1 is shown on Deposited Plan No. 408972, held by the Western Australian Land Information Authority trading as Landgate.

Guildford Road from East Parade to Tonkin Highway

Call for Public Submissions

The Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) intends to amend the Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS) for land in the local governments of Bayswater and Vincent and is seeking public comment.

The amendment seeks to modify the Primary Regional Road (PRR) reservation boundaries currently reserved in the MRS for the section of Guildford Road between East Parade and Tonkin Highway.

Amending the PRR reservation for this section of Guildford Road will provide clarity and certainty for future road planning/development and facilitate orderly land use planning to occur along this corridor.
