Associations Incorporation Act 2015

Associations Incorporation Amendment Regulations 2017

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the Associations Incorporation Amendment Regulations 2017.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the Associations Incorporation Regulations 2016.

4. Regulation 19 amended

(1) In regulation 19(1) before the 1st alphabetical definition insert in numerical order:

1987 Act notice means a notice of an address for service lodged under Associations Incorporation Act 1987 section 40;

(2) In regulation 19(1) insert in alphabetical order:

address for service means an address or postal address for service of any process, notice or other document;

- (3) In regulation 19(2):
 - (a) delete paragraph (a) and insert:
 - (a) before the commencement day the association lodged a 1987 Act notice; and
 - (b) in paragraph (b) before "notice" insert:

1987 Act

- (4) After regulation 19(2) insert:
 - (3) Where an existing incorporated association has not lodged notice of an address for service under the Act
 - (a) the address for service given in the 1987 Act notice most recently lodged by the association before the commencement day is taken for the purposes of section 176 of the Act to have been notified to the Commissioner under section 174; or
 - (b) if the association has not lodged a 1987 Act notice, the address which appears to the Commissioner to be or most recently to have been the address of the association is taken for the purposes of section 176 of the Act to have been notified to the Commissioner under section 174.
 - (4) An address for service lodged with the Commissioner under section 203(1)(b) or (2)(b) of the Act is taken for the purposes of section 176 of the Act to have been notified to the Commissioner under section 174.

- (a) in paragraph (a) delete "organisation;" and insert:
 - organisation, unless the applicant is incorporated under the Associations Incorporation Act 2015;
- (b) in paragraph (a) delete "certified";
- (c) in paragraph (b) delete "certified".

BIOSECURITY AND AGRICULTURE MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS 2013

QUARANTINE AREA REVOCATION NOTICE

The Quarantine Area Notice—Tomato Potato Psyllid Perth Metropolitan Area, published in the *Gazette* and the West Australian Newspaper and on the Department of Agriculture and Food website on 2 March 2017, is revoked and replaced by the following notice.

BIOSECURITY AND AGRICULTURE MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS 2013

QUARANTINE AREA NOTICE—TOMATO POTATO PSYLLID PERTH METROPOLITAN AREA AND SPECIFIED ADJACENT SHIRES

- 1. Under regulation 60 of the *Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Regulations 2013* (Regulations) the Perth metropolitan area, being the Perth Statistical Division according to the Australian Bureau of Statistics, together with the shires of Murray, Chittering and Gingin, is declared to constitute a quarantine area until 30 June 2017.
- 2. This quarantine area is declared because the declared pest Tomato Potato Psyllid (TPP) (Bactericera cockerelli (Sulc)) is present in the area.
- 3. To prevent the spread of TPP to other areas of the State, a commercial consignor must not move, or cause or allow to be moved, any host plants or any machinery, equipment, soil or other plant growing medium used in connection with host plants from a place within the quarantine area to a place outside the quarantine area except in accordance with—
 - 3.1. this notice; or
 - 3.2. an approval under regulation 67 of the Regulations; or
 - 3.3. a general exemption under regulation 71 of the Regulations.
- 4. Host plants and other things mentioned in clause 3 which are produced, packed or used on a property which is within the quarantine area or which is a quarantined place outside the Quarantine Area are moved in accordance with this notice if those things are—
 - 4.1. Prepared no more than 60 hours prior to movement as follows, evidenced by records which include details of treatment, transporters and consignees—
 - For tomato plants and seedlings—
 - Sprayed with 60mL/100L of the 100g/L active of bifenthrin or the 600mL/ha of the 18g/L abamectin, and no less than 24 hours later
 - Sprayed with 200mL/100L of the 225g/L active of methomyl
 - For capsicum plants and seedlings—
 - Sprayed with 800mL/ha of the 100g/L active of bifenthrin or 300mL/ha of the 18g/L abamectin, and no less than 24 hours later
 - Sprayed with 200mL/100L of the 225g/L active of methomyl
 - For eggplant plants and seedlings—
 - Sprayed with 280mL/ha of the 100g/L active of alpha-cypermethrin or 450mL/ha of the 18g/L abamectin, and no less than 24 hours later
 - Sprayed with 200mL/100L to a max of 1-2 L/ha of the 225g/L active of methomyl
 - · For chilli plants and seedlings-
 - Sprayed with 280mL/ha of the 100g/L active of alpha-cypermethrin, and no less than 24 hours later
 - Sprayed with 200mL/100L to a max of 1-2L/ha of the 225g/L active of methomyl
 - For host plant ornamentals/nursery stock—
 - Sprayed with 6mL product per 10L of the 80g/L active of bifenthrin or 50mL/100L to a maximum of 1.5L for 18g/L abamectin, and no less than 24 hours later
 - Sprayed with 200mL with 100L water of the 225g/L active of methomyl
 - For solanaceous or convolvulaceous fruit/vegetables (other than potato or sweet potato tubers) produced and/or packed in the quarantine area or on a quarantined place outside the quarantine area—
 - Prepared in an approved manner published on the department's website

- For machinery and equipment—
 - Washed free of plant material and soil with high pressure hot water or treated with an insecticide registered for the control of TPP at rates specified on the label (or used under an approved minor use permit); or
- 4.2. Prepared in an approved manner published on the department's website; or
- 4.3. Certified by an inspector as having been prepared in accordance with the directions of an inspector.
- 5. Potatoes and sweet potato tubers may be moved from the quarantine area provided they are free from above ground plant material.
- 6. Solanaceous and convolvulaceous fruit/vegetables which were produced and packed outside the quarantine area other than on a quarantined place outside the quarantine area may be moved from the quarantine area provided these remain secured in their original packaging with records available which include details of production address (and packing address if different), transporters and consignees.
- 7. Each person who is the owner or occupier of land in the quarantine area is taken to have been given a quarantine notice that applies to that land in the terms of this quarantine area notice.
- 8. Failure to comply with this quarantine area notice could result in a fine, the Director General taking remedial action under section 133 of the *Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Act 2007*, or both.
