RACING AND WAGERING WESTERN AUSTRALIA ACT 2003

RACING AND WAGERING WESTERN AUSTRALIA (FOB RULES) NOTICE (No. 2) 2017

Made by Racing and Wagering Western Australia under section 61 of the Act.

1. Citation

This notice is the Racing and Wagering Western Australia (FOB Rules) Notice (No. 2) 2017.

2. Commencement

These rules came into operation on 12 June 2012.

3. Interpretation

In this notice—

"the Act" means the Racing and Wagering Western Australia Act 2003;

"the Rules" means the rules described in clause 4, adopted by Racing and Wagering Western Australia.

4. Rules adopted under section 61 of the Act

- (1) In a meeting held on 31 May 2012, Racing and Wagering Western Australia resolved—
 - (a) to adopt and operate under rules relating to a jointly operated fixed odds wagering system in accordance with section 61(2) and (4) of the Act.
- (2) A copy of the rules adopted was published for public information in the Special Gazette of 12 June 2012 at pp. 2413-2441.
- (3) Further amendments to the Rules were adopted by resolution of the Board dated 11 October 2012, 25 March 2013 30 August 2013, 31 October 2013, 20 December 2013, 1 May 2014, 3 September 2014, 28 November 2014, 21 September 2015, 23 November 2015, 21 January 2016, 29 February 2016, 4 April 2016, 27 June 2016, 25 July 2016, 29 August 2016, 3 October 2016, 31 October 2016 and 27 February 2017 and published for public information in the Gazettes of 23 October 2012 at pp. 5058-5060, 5 April 2013 at pp. 1490-1491, 17 September 2013 at pp. 4337-4346, 15 November 2013 at pp. 5262-5265, 10 January 2014 at pp 24-25, 13 May 2014 at pp 1455-1465, 12 September 2014 at pp 3290-3291, 5 December 2014 at pp 4523-4525, 25 September 2015 at pp 3881-3883, 27 November at pp 4756-4758 29 January 2016 at pp 276-277, 4 March 2016 at pp 627-628, 8 April 2016 at pp 1101-1103, 1 July 2016 at pp 2748-2749, 29 July 2016 at pp 3215-3217, 2 September at pp 3713-3714, 7 October 2016 at pp 4379-4387, 4 November 2016 at pp 5010-5011 and 3 March 2016 at pp 1482-1484.

5. Changes to Rules published for public information section 61(6)(c) of the Act

- (1) Further amendments to the Rules were adopted by resolution of the Board dated 28 November 2016
- (2) Those further amendments to the Rules are published in the Schedule to this notice for public information, as required by section 61(6)(c) of the Act.

Schedule 1—Amendments to Adopted Rules

- 30 As regards wagers placed by Clients—
 - (c) All wagers are accepted by RWWA in Western Australia at the times as set out in these Rules and—
 - (i) Except in the case of "In the Run" wagering and In-Play Racing Markets, wagers may be accepted in accordance with Rules 32 and 33 up to the advertised start time, actual start time, or such earlier other time as dictated determined by RWWA.
 - (ii) Except in the case of "In the Run" wagering and In-Play Racing Markets, if a wager is inadvertently accepted in respect of an event after its start time or the time determined by RWWA in accordance

with Rule 30(c)(i), the wager shall be deemed to have been made invalidly and will be refunded to the Client. For the purpose of this clause, "inadvertently" means that RWWA had no knowledge that the event in question had started and the wager was accepted in good faith.

WESTERN AUSTRALIAN MARINE ACT 1982 NAVIGABLE WATERS REGULATIONS 1958

RESTRICTED SPEED AREAS—ALL VESSELS City of Belmont Autumn River Festival 2017

> Department of Transport, Fremantle WA, 28th March 2017.

Acting pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 67 of the Western Australian Marine Act 1982 the department by this notice revokes Notice MA401 as published in the Government Gazette on 27 March 2012 relating to the 5 knot speed restriction applicable from 400m downstream of Ron Courtney Island to 400m upstream of Ron Courtney Island, Swan River.

Also, acting pursuant to the powers conferred by Regulation 48A of the *Navigable Waters Regulations 1958*, the department by this notice permits water skiing within the same designated area as stated above.

Also, acting pursuant to the powers conferred by Regulation 10A(b) of the *Navigable Waters Regulations* 1958, the department by this notice prohibits swimming within the same designated area as stated above

These amendments are only applicable between the hours of 11:00 am and 3:30 pm on Sunday 2nd April 2017 and the speed limit change is only applicable to bona fide vessels associated with the City of Belmont Autumn River Festival 2017 water ski display.
