Alteration of Statutory Designations Act 1974

Alteration of Statutory Designations Order 2017

Made by the deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

This order is the *Alteration of Statutory Designations Order 2017*.

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation on 1 July 2017.

3. References to Department of Commerce altered

- (1) A reference to the Department of Commerce contained in any law, or in any instrument, contract, or legal proceedings made or commenced before 1 July 2017, is to be read and construed as a reference to the relevant successor.
- (2) In subclause (1) —

relevant successor means —

- (a) the Department of Jobs, Tourism, Science and Innovation if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department; or
- (b) the Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department.
- (3) Subclause (1) does not apply to a reference if the context of the reference requires otherwise.

4. References to Department of Environment and Conservation altered

- (1) A reference to the Department of Environment and Conservation contained in any law is to be read and construed as a reference to the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions.
- (2) A reference to the Department of Environment and Conservation contained in any instrument, contract, or legal proceedings made or commenced before 1 July 2017 is to be read and construed as a reference to the relevant successor.

(3) In subclause (2) —

relevant successor means —

- (a) the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department; or
- (b) the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department.
- (4) Subclauses (1) and (2) do not apply to a reference if the context of the reference requires otherwise.

5. References to Department of Local Government and Communities altered

- A reference to the Department of Local Government and Communities contained in any law, or in any instrument, contract, or legal proceedings made or commenced before 1 July 2017, is to be read and construed as a reference to the relevant successor.
- (2) In subclause (1) —

relevant successor means —

- (a) the Department of Communities if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department; or
- (b) the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department.
- (3) Subclause (1) does not apply to a reference if the context of the reference requires otherwise.

6. References to Department of Planning and Infrastructure altered

- (1) A reference to the Department of Planning and Infrastructure contained in any law, or in any instrument, contract, or legal proceedings made or commenced before 1 July 2017, is to be read and construed as a reference to the relevant successor.
- (2) In subclause (1) —

relevant successor means —

(a) the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function,

office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department; or

- (b) the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department; or
- (c) the Department of Transport if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2009 became a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department.
- (3) Subclause (1) does not apply to a reference if the context of the reference requires otherwise.

7. References to Department of Regional Development and Lands altered

- A reference to the Department of Regional Development and Lands contained in any law, or in any instrument, contract, or legal proceedings made or commenced before 1 July 2017, is to be read and construed as a reference to the relevant successor.
- (2) In subclause (1) —

relevant successor means —

- (a) the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department; or
- (b) the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department.
- (3) Subclause (1) does not apply to a reference if the context of the reference requires otherwise.

8. References to various departments altered

- (1) A reference contained in any law, or in any instrument, contract, or legal proceedings made or commenced before 1 July 2017, to a department of the Public Service with a designation set out in the 2nd column of an item in the Table is to be read and construed as a reference to the department of the Public Service with the designation set out in the 3rd column of that item.
- (2) Subclause (1) does not apply to a reference if the context of the reference requires otherwise.

- (6) under the *Public Sector Management Act 1994* section 35(1)(b), amalgamated the departments designated the Department of the Attorney General and the Department of Corrective Services; and designated the resulting department as the Department of Justice with effect on and from 1 July 2017; and
- (7) under the *Public Sector Management Act 1994* section 35(1)(b), amalgamated the Department of Education and the Department of Education Services; and designated the resulting department as the Department of Education with effect on and from 1 July 2017; and
- (8) under the *Public Sector Management Act 1994* section 35(1)(b), amalgamated the departments designated the Department of Planning, the Department of Lands, the Department of the State Heritage Office and the Department of Aboriginal Affairs; and designated the resulting department as the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage with effect on and from 1 July 2017; and
- (9) under the Public Sector Management Act 1994 section 35(1)(d), altered the designation of the Department of Parks and Wildlife; and designated it as the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions with effect on and from 1 July 2017; and
- (10) under the *Public Sector Management Act 1994* section 35(1)(b), amalgamated the departments designated the Department of Water, the Department of Environment Regulation and the Office of the Environmental Protection Authority; and designated the resulting department as the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation with effect on and from 1 July 2017; and
- (11) under the *Public Sector Management Act 1994* section 35(1)(c), abolished the department designated the Road Safety Commission with effect on and from 1 July 2017.
