Liquor Control Act 1988

Liquor Control (Section 31) Notice 2019

Issued under the *Liquor Control Act 1988* sections 31(4) and (7) and 60 by the Director of Liquor Licensing.

1. Citation

This notice is the *Liquor Control (Section 31) Notice 2019*.

2. Commencement

This notice comes into operation as follows —

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 — on the day on which this notice is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the notice — on the day after that day.

3. Extended trading permit varying authorisation conferred by hotel licence or liquor store licence: premises within metropolitan area

- (1) This clause applies to a licence that relates to premises situated in the metropolitan area if the licence is either —
 - (a) a hotel licence that is not a hotel restricted licence or tavern restricted licence; or
 - (b) a liquor store licence.
- (2) An extended trading permit is issued under section 60 of the Act in respect of the licence for the purposes referred to in subsection (4)(g) of that section.
- (3) The extended trading permit varies the authorisation conferred by the licence so as to authorise the licensee to sell packaged liquor on and from the licensed premises from 8 am to 10 am on 15, 22 and 29 December 2019.
- (4) The extended trading permit remains in force until the end of 29 December 2019.

4. Extended trading permit varying authorisation conferred by liquor store licence: premises outside metropolitan area

- (1) This clause applies to a liquor store licence that relates to premises situated outside the metropolitan area unless it is a licence listed in Schedule 1.
- (2) An extended trading permit is issued under section 60 of the Act in respect of the licence for the purposes referred to in subsection (4)(g) of that section.
- (3) The extended trading permit varies the authorisation conferred by the licence so as to authorise the licensee to sell packaged liquor on and from the licensed premises from 10 am to 10 pm on the following days —
 - (a) 27 January 2019;
 - (b) 3 March 2019;
 - (c) 21 April 2019;
 - (d) 2 June 2019;
 - (e) 29 September 2019;
 - (f) 15, 22 and 29 December 2019.
- (4) The extended trading permit remains in force until the end of 29 December 2019.

TEMPORARY NOTICE TO MARINERS

Closure of Waters to Boating
Thomson Bay Rottnest Island
Special Event 13th January 2019

Acting pursuant to the powers conferred by Regulation 38B of the *Rottnest Island Regulations 1988*, the Rottnest Island Authority hereby closes the following waters to all vessels excluding bona fide emergency vessels, vessels authorised to use swing moorings accessing the area solely for the purpose of attaching to moorings TB063, TB035, TB352, TB070, TB068, TB271 and tenders up to 3.75m transiting to and from the beach, between 6.00am on Sunday 13th January 2019 to 10.00am Monday 14th January 2019.

Thomson Bay

All the waters enclosed by a line commencing from the shoreline at the start of the Fuel Jetty, east to the south eastern end of the Fuel Jetty head, south to the northern point of the Hotel Jetty, along the face of the Hotel Jetty a point 55 metres south of the Hotel Jetty and 30 metres from the shore line, continuing south 166m and 30 metres from the shoreline then west to the shoreline at a point 237m south of the start of the Hotel Jetty.

These waters include the swing moorings TB063, TB035, TB352, TB070, TB068, and TB271

Due to the large number of persons attending this special event the closure has been introduced to assist in the management of people and vessels to ensure public safety. Appropriate signage will be placed on site.
