Local Government (Port Hedland - Declaration of Vacancies and Appointment of Commissioner) Order 2019

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

This order is the *Local Government (Port Hedland - Declaration of Vacancies and Appointment of Commissioner) Order 2019*.

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*.

3. Term used: council

In this order —

council means the council of the Town of Port Hedland.

4. Offices of members of council declared vacant

More than half of the offices of members of the council being vacant, all the remaining offices of members of the council are declared under section 2.37(1) of the Act to be vacant on and from the day on which this order comes into operation.

5. Commissioner appointed

Under section 2.37(4) of the Act, the Honourable Fredrick Riebeling is appointed to be the commissioner of the Town of Port Hedland until the offices of members of the council are filled again and the new council holds its first meeting.

6. Polling day fixed

Under section 2.37(5) of the Act, the day fixed for any poll needed for the election of members to fill the vacant offices is 17 October 2020.
