RETAIL TRADING HOURS (SHIRE OF LAKE GRACE) CHRISTMAS VARIATION ORDER 2019 Made by the Minister for Commerce under section 12E of the Act.

1. Citation

This order is the Retail Trading Hours (Shire of Lake Grace) Christmas Variation Order 2019.

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation as follows—

- (a) clauses 1 and 2—on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the order—on the day after that day.

3. Variation of retail trading hours

- (1) For the period commencing on Monday 2 December 2019 and ending on Wednesday 1 January 2020, (both dates inclusive), general retail shops, other than motor vehicle shops, in the Lake Grace local government district, are authorised to be open, at times when those shops would otherwise be required to be closed—
 - (a) on each Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, from 6.00 pm until 9.00 pm; and
 - (b) on each Sunday and public holiday, from 11.00 am until 5.00 pm.
- (2) Despite subclause 3(1), general retail shops in the Lake Grace local government district are required to be closed on Christmas Day, Wednesday 25 December 2019.
