#### LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995

City of South Perth

HEALTH AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2019

Under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995* and by all other powers, the Council of the City of South Perth resolved on 26 November 2019 to make the following local law.
