
REVOCATION OF DECLARATION OF ABANDONED MINE SITE

The power conferred by Clause 5.5.1 of this Scheme shall not apply to clauses 6.8.8 a), 6.8.9, 6.8.10, 6.8.11, 6.8.12, 6.8.13 and the Maximum Car Parking standards of Table 6.8.14 a).

- b. Inserting the following note under Table 6.8.14 a)—
 - "5. Where an existing non-residential development, with approved parking in excess of the provisions set out in Table 6.8.14 a) of the Scheme Text applies for redevelopment, the City may, at its discretion, permit the existing level of parking to remain, subject to all of the parking in excess of the permitted level of car parking being provided and managed as Public Parking as outlined in Table 6.8.14 a)".
- c. Replacing the symbol 'X' with the symbol 'D' for a 'Nursing Home' use in the 'Mixed Use' Land Use Sector of Table 6.8.6—Mirrabooka Town Centre Land Use Permissibility Table

d. Delete clause 6.8.10 c)

A minimum of 1,411m 2 of open space will be sought for purchase by the City on Lot 507 adjacent to the existing Town Square for expansion of Town Square.
