CONSERVATION AND LAND MANAGEMENT ACT 1984

APPROVAL OF THE FOREST MANAGEMENT PLAN 2024-2033

- 1. Notice is hereby given that the Hon Reece Whitby MLA, Minister for Environment, has approved the Forest Management Plan 2024-2033 pursuant to section 60 of the *Conservation and Land Management Act 1984*.
- 2. The Forest Management Plan 2024-2033 specifies that indigenous State forest are reserved for a combination of the following purposes—
 - (a) conservation;
 - (b) recreation;
 - (c) water catchment protection; and
 - (d) other purposes being the purposes prescribed in regulation 81 of the Conservation and Land Management Regulations 2002.
