Extending the Period of Closure for Net Fishing in Leschenault Estuary.

E.C. 1888 PROCLAMATION

ARTHUR LAWLEY. Governor. L.S.

Western Australia, By His Excellency the Honourable Sir Arthur Lawley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, etc., etc., etc.

THEREAS by Proclamation dated the 28th day of December, 1900, published in the Government Gazette of 4th January, 1901, Net Fishing was declared to be prohibited in the Leschenault Estuary until 31st December, 1901: AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to extend such period mentioned in the above recited Proclamation: Now therefore I, the Governor aforesaid, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby declare that the period prohibiting Net Fishing within such limits shall be extended to 31st January, 1902.

THEREAS by the provisions of Section 4 of "The Noxious Weeds Act, 1900," it is made lawful for the Governor in Council, on the recom-mendation of a Municipal Council, to declare any plants to be noxious weeds, either generally or in any particular locality: And whereas the Municipal Council of Northam has recommended that the plant known as "Spanish Radish" (Raphanus Raphanistrum) should be declared a "noxious weed" within the Municipality of Northam: Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare the plant known as "Spanish Radish" to be a "Noxious Weed" within the Municipality of Northam.
