WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency the Honourable Sir ARTHUR LAWLEY, Knight Com-mander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, etc., etc., etc.

W HEREAS by "The Transfer of Land Act, 1893, Amendment Act, 1896" (60 Vict, No. 22), the Governor was empowered, by Proclamation in the Government Gazette, to revest in her late Majesty, her heirs or successors, as of her or their former estate, all or any lands whereof Her Majesty then was, or Her Majesty, or her heirs or successors, might thereafter become the registered proprietor or proprietors: AND WHEREAS His Majesty King Edward the Seventh is now the registered proprietor of Day Dawn Town Lot 30, registered in the Office of Titles in Volume XCV., Folio 72: Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this Proclamation revest in His Majesty King Edward the Seventh, his heirs and successors, Day Dawn Town Lot 30 aforesaid as of his former estate.

TTHEREAS by Section 15 of "The Health Act 1898," the Governor may appoint any number of persons, not exceeding seven, to be a Local Board of Health for any district not forming part of a Municipal District : Now, THEREFORE, His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, does hereby appoint the undermentioned persons to be a Local Board of Health for the District to be known as West Guildford, in the Swan Magisterial District, and to include all lands within the following boundaries:-

Bounded by lines starting from the East corner of Swan Location T, on the right bank of the Swan River, and extending North-West along part of that location's North-East boundary to the West corner of Swan Location Q1; thence East along the North boundary of said Location Q1 and part of the South boundary of Swan Location P to the right bank of the Swan River aforesaid, and along it downwards to the starting point.
