Purchase Money due for the Half-year ending 30th June, 1902, and payable to the Minister for Lands, at the Department of Lands and Surveys, Perth, or to his agents at the various Resident Magistrates' Courts in the State, on or before 1st March.

Failing payment of the half-year's rent on 1st March renders the lessee or licensee liable to the fines prescribed by Section 136 of "The Land Act, 1898"; and failing payment within 90 days after the 1st March renders the lease or license liable to forfeiture.

In order that the nature of the holding or tenure in every case may be easily understood, the following reference, explaining the meaning of the figures prefixed to the numbers in the Return, is given.

The number or letter prefixed indicates the nature of the holding or tenure, and the number following indicates the number of the holding or lease.

An asterisk (\*) before the amount of rent of pastoral leases indicates that rent will be reduced by one-half if a satisfactory stock certificate is furnished by 1st March.
