HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has been pleased to make the following Regulations under "The Trade Unions Act, 1902."

Regulations under the Trade Unions Act, 1902.
(1 & 2 Edw. VII., No. 19.)

In pursuance of the powers and authorities conferred by "The Trade Unions Act, 1902," and of every other power and authority enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth make the following Regulations, that is to say:—

1. In the following Regulations and Forms the term "Registrar" shall mean the Registrar of Friendly Societies appointed under "The Friendly Societies Act, 1894," and the term "the Act" shall mean "The Trade Unions Act, 1902."

Section 17 (3) of Act.

2. The Registrar shall not register a trade union under a name identical with that of any other existing trade union known to him, whether registered or not registered, or so nearly resembling such name as to be likely, in his opinion, to deceive the members or the public.
