#### Claims:—

1. In the operation of testing and standardising playing bowls, an inclined shoot formed with a trough or curved bottom imparting the necessary initial impulse to the bowl, substantially as and for the purposes herein set forth and explained and as illustrated in the accompanying drawings.

2. In the operation of testing and standardising playing bowls an adjustably arranged marker or guide for approximately ascertaining the amount of alteration necessary to be made to a bowl of an untrue bias, substantially as and for the purposes herein set forth and explained and as illustrated in the accompanying drawings.

3. In the operation of testing and standardising playing bowls, an inclined shoot as A an adjustable marker as N in combination with a testing table or level as D, substantially as and for the purposes herein set forth and explained and as illustrated in the accompanying drawings.

3. The combination in apparatus for the purpose specified of a vessel having a perforated bottom and a closed top, an air cock provided with a bell crank operating lever, a chain depending from the ends of the bell crank lever and means for connecting said vessel to a cord whereby it may be raised as specified and illustrated.

4. The combination in apparatus for the purpose specified of a vessel having a perforated bottom and a closed top an air cock provided with a bell crank operating lever, and air pump for withdrawing air from said vessel and means for connecting the suction from said pump and the vessel as specified.

5. The combination and arrangement of parts comprising my improved portable shower bath substantially as set forth.
