THE STATE FUNERAL

OF THE LATE HONOURABLE
GEORGE LEAKE,
K.C., M.L.A.,
Premier of Western Australia,
ON THURSDAY, 26th JUNE, 1902.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR in Executive Council has been pleased to direct that the honour of a State Funeral shall be accorded to the remains of the late Honourable GEORGE LEAKE, K.C., Premier of Western Australia, who died at 11.15 p.m. on Tuesday, the 24th instant.

A Funeral Service will be held in the Cathedral at 3 p.m., after which the coffin will be conveyed to the hearse in St. George's Terrace, through a lane of the military drawn up from the Cathedral door to the Cathedral gates, in St. George's Terrace.

The coffin will be conveyed by Foot Police.

Here the procession will form. Lieutenant-Colonel Campbell, Acting Commandant of Defence Forces, and Captain Hare, Commissioner of Police, will have entire control of the arrangements connected with the procession and ceremony.
