"Improvements in apparatus for Elastic Fluid Compression."-Dated 9th October, 1902.

Claims :

1. In apparatus for elastic fluid compression the combination with two sets of toggle levers coupled together, of a free or floating beam receiving motion therefrom and transmitting it to the compressing pistons, substantially as hereinbefore described and explained.

In apparatus for elastic fluid compression the combination with a free beam operated by two sets of toggles coupled together, of baanced supports for the beam free to rise and fall in framing to suit the varying plane of lever joints, substantially as hereinbefore described and explained.
In apparatus for elastic fluid compression the combination with a free beam and its yielding supports, of two sets of toggle levers, whose power can be utilised up to their exhaustion, substantially as herein-before described and explained.
In apparatus for elastic fluid compression the combination with a free beam and its yielding supports, of toggles operating the same by an overstep movement towards the vertical centre to complete the compression stroke, substantially as hereinbefore described and ex-plained.
In apparatus for elastic fluid compression the combination with
