PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, TO WIT.) E. A. STONE, Administrator. [L.S.]

By His Excellency Sir EDWARD ALBERT STONE, Knight, Administrator of the Government in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, etc., etc., etc.

WHEREAS by "The Goldfields Water Supply Act, 1902," it is enacted that this Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation: Now THEREFORE I, Sir Edward Albert Stone, Knight, Administrator as aforesaid, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by the said Act, do by this my Proclamation fix the Seventh day of February, One thousand nine hundred and three, as the day on which the said Act shall come into operation.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 6th day of February, 1903.
