Claims:—

1. An ore smelting furnace as a having one or more flues as a1 and a water jacket as c1 and an adjustably operated feed hopper as b to b3 and provided with a steam jet blast or ejector as a2 for generating and maintaining a forced draft substantially as and for the purposes herein set forth and as illustrated in Figures 1 and 2 of the attached drawings.

2. An ore smelting furnace as a having one or more flues as a1 and a water jacket as c1 and an adjustably operated feed hopper as b to b3 and provided with a hot air feed apparatus as e to e3 placed at the lowermost opening of the furnace for generating and maintaining a forced draft substantially as and for the purposes herein set forth and as illustrated in Figures 3 and 4 of the attached drawings.

3. In combination with the ore furnaces as above set forth and claimed a crucible as d having grooves as d1 and lip as d2 said crucible being arranged to slide on and along a vertically adjustable frame as d4 for regulating the furnace draft substantially as herein set forth and as illustrated in the drawings attached hereto.
