GOLDFIELDS WATER SUPPLY ACT, 1902. NOTICE OF RATE IN THE BOULDER WATER DISTRICT.

 \mathbb{N} OTICE is hereby given that the Rate Book of all land and premises in the above district now liable to be rated under this Act has been made up and may be inspected at the Goldfields Water Supply Office, Burt Street, Boulder (opposite Municipal Chambers).

Notice is hereby given that under the powers conferred by "The Goldfields Water Supply Act, 1902," the Minister for Works has ordered a rate of $4\frac{1}{2}d$ in the £ (being at the rate of 1s. 6d. in the £ per annum) to be made and levied for the unexpired portion of the current year, namely, from 1st October to 31st December, 1903, upon all ratable land entered in the Rate Book, the making up of which is this day published in the *Government Gazette* and the *Boulder* Star, the minimum rate for the above-mentioned period to be five shillings upon any land the annual rate of which, at 1s. 6d. in the \pounds , would not exceed \pounds 1; and that a memorandum of such order has been duly entered in the Rate Book and signed.

The said rate is now payable by the occupiers and owners of the said land.

Every ratepaying consumer will be entitled to a supply Every ratepaying consumer will be entitled to a supply of water at the rate of Ss. per thousand gallons in return for the amount of rates paid by him. Provided that such water shall be taken during the period for which the rate is struck, and that the maximum quantity to be taken in consideration of the rate, during any one quarter of a year, shall not exceed one-fourth of the supply to which the con-sumer is entitled in respect of an annual rate, or one-half of the supply to which be is entitled in respect of a half. of the supply to which he is entitled in respect of a halfyearly rate.

Any consumer taking water in excess of the quantity to which he is entitled in respect of a rate will be charged 8s. per thousand gallons for so much as is taken in respect of the rate, and 7s. 6d. per thousand gallons for the excess up to a total consumption of eight thousand gallons per quarter, and 7s. per thousand gallons for any excess beyond a total consumption of eight thousand gallons per quarter.

Every quarter shall end 31st March or 30th June or 30th September or 31st December in every year.

GOLDFIELDS WATER SUPPLY ACT, 1902. NOTICE OF RATE IN THE KALGOORLIE WATER DISTRICT.

N OTICE is hereby given that under the powers con-ferred by "The Goldfields Water Supply Act, 1902," the Minister for Works has this day amended the Rate Book, the making up of which was published in the *Govern-*ment Gazette of 31st July, 1903, by the insertion of parment Gazette of sist July, 1903, by the insertion of par-ticulars of additional property ratable at this date, and that the rate on such additional property is fourpence halfpenny in the pound (being at the rate of one shilling and sixpence in the pound per annum) for the unexpired portion of the current year, namely, from 1st October, 1903, to 31st December, 1903.

The said rate is now payable by occupiers and owners of the said land.
