#### Claims:—

1. An improved ruler constructed substantially as herein described and illustrated in the drawing.
2. A ruler of approximately triangular section having an edge to be used as a guide in ruling lines projecting from the angle which is uppermost when the ruler is in operative position, substantially as specified and illustrated.
3. A ruler having a flat side 1 adapted in use to rest upon the paper, a vertical side 6 and inclined side 3, a longitudinal groove 5 in side 3, and a guide edge 7 projecting beyond the vertical side 6 as specified.

An improved extension sofa consisting of a fixed body frame and head piece the former carrying a hinged back piece and the latter a folding extension piece, said hinged back piece being provided with a pair of folding legs controlled by a pair of pivotted connecting rods which act also as stays for the sofa back and legs respectively substantially as described and as illustrated in the drawings.

2. The combination and arrangement in an improved extension sofa of a rigid body frame and head piece with a hinged back piece provided with a pair of folding legs controlled and stayed by a pair of connecting rods and a folding extension head piece, substantially as described and as illustrated in the drawings.
