#### Claims:

- The improvement in the marking of concrete street pavements and ways, and floors, and the like, consisting of the use of moulds having a pattern or design on their under surfaces and the interposition between the said mould, and the plastic composite or concrete surface of the pavement of a wet or damp cloth or sheet of fabric which will hold moisture substantially as herein described and explained.
- In the improvement as set out in the preceding (first) claim the wetting or dampening of a calico sheet or other fabric in a solution of silicate of soda in water substantially as herein described and explained.
