1. In link blade liners for centrifugal separator bowls a plurality of blades mounted upon a common rod or link at different levels substantially as and for the purposes set forth.

2. In link blade liners for centrifugal separator bowls a pair of blades mounted upon a common rod or link connecting the upper and lower rings of the liner, one of said blades having lugs bent round said rod or link above and below such rings, with a longitudinal rebate between, and the other blade having a comparatively large lug bent round said rod or link between the rings and rabbeted above and below same substantially as set forth.
