IN LUNACY.

LUNACY RULES.

IN pursuance of the powers vested in us by Section 176 of the "Lunacy Act of 1903," we do order and direct in manner following:—

PRELIMINARY.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Lunacy Rules, 1905, and shall come into operation on the sixth day of June, 1905. Short title and commencement.
2. Pending proceedings shall be carried on according to the provisions of these Rules, so far as possible, and subject thereto according to the practice heretofore subsisting, and in case of doubt as to the mode of procedure in such of these modes as the Master directs. The provisions of these Rules shall be subject to variation by special order in any case, and shall apply only where no express directions are given by any special order concerning any of the matters provided for in these Rules, or so far as such directions do not extend. In all matters not provided for by these Rules the mode of procedure heretofore in force shall continue to be followed. Pending proceedings.
3. The provisions of the 3rd section of the "Interpretation Act, 1898," and of Section 4 of the "Lunacy Act of 1903" shall apply so far as applicable to these Rules, and in these Rules the expression "the Act" shall mean the "Lunacy Act of 1903," and the expression "the Manager" shall mean the person appointed to undertake the care and management of the property of any incapable person. Interpretation.
4. The Court or Master may enlarge or abridge the time appointed by these Rules or fixed by any order enlarging time for doing any act or taking any proceeding upon such terms (if any) as the justice of the case requires, and any such enlargement may be ordered although the application for the same is not made until after the expiration of the time appointed or allowed. Power to enlarge or abridge time.
