THE EARLY CLOSING ACT, 1902.

PROCLAMATION

Western Australia, to wit.

By His Excellency Admiral Sir Frederick George Denham Bedford, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, etc., etc., etc., etc., etc.

WHEREAS by Section 23 of "The Early Closing Act, 1902," the Governor may by Proclamation temporarily suspend the operation of this Act in so far as it applies to the closing time fixed or appointed for any shop or shops: And whereas the time for closing shops in Geraldton has by Proclamation been fixed as 1 p.m. on Wednesday: And whereas it is the desire of the shopkeepers of the Town of Geraldton to have the operation of the said Act suspended between the hours of 1 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Wednesday, the 27th of September, 1905: Now Therefore I, the said Governor, do with the advice of the Executive Council hereby suspend the operation of the said Act in regard to the Town of Geraldton between the hours of 1 p.m. and 6 p.m. of the said date accordingly.
