PROCLAMATION

Western Australia, To Wit.

By His Excellency Admiral Sir Frederick George Denham Bedford, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, etc., etc., etc., etc., etc.

HEREAS it is desirable that the Legislative Assembly should be dissolved: Now THEREFORE I,
Admiral Sir Frederick George Denham Bedford, G.C.B., in pursuance of the power and
authority vested in me as Governor of the State, do hereby dissolve the Legislative Assembly of Western
Australia from and after this date, and the same stands dissolved accordingly.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 5th day of October, 1905.
