CITY OF PERTH.

By-law No. 25.

Amendment.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906," the Mayor and Councillors of the City of Perth do hereby order as follows:—

Section 8 of By-law No. 25, regulating the erection of hoardings on private property, is hereby repealed, and the following section is substituted in lieu thereof:—

8. The fee for a license under this By-law shall be at the rate of twopence for every superficial yard comprised in such hoarding, provided that the minimum fee for a license shall be ten shillings.
