Department of Lands and Surveys, Perth, 30th November, 1909.

Under the power reserved to the Hon. the Minister, the whole of the Leases and Licenses have been withdrawn from sale, but the land comprised therein, save such areas as it may in the meant me be decided to reserve, will be made available for re-selection on and after 4th January, 1910, under the conditions prescribed in the Land Laws and Regulations now in force.

All applications for land in the South-Western Division must be lodged at the offices of the Land Agents for the district in which the land is situate.

All improvements existing on any lots are the property of the Crown, and shall be paid for by the Selector as the Hon. the Minister for Lands may direct.
