FUNERAL OF HIS LATE MOST GRACIOUS MAJESTY KING EDWARD VII.

GENERAL MOURNING TO BE OBSERVED.

HIS Excellency the Governor directs it to be notified, for general information, that Court Mourning will be observed by the Court of His Majesty the King until 6th May, 1911. The duration of public mourning throughout the Empire has not yet been fixed; it will commence from 12th May, from which date it is expected that suitable mourning will be worn in Western Australia. A further notification will be published when official information is received as regards the period established for general mourning.
