Wednesday, the 27th September, 1911, at Goomalling.
Wednesday, the 27th September, 1911, at Dowerin.
Wednesday, the 27th September, 1911, at Northam.
Thursday, the 28th September, 1911, at Northam.
Thursday, the 28th September, 1911, at Northampton.
Thursday, the 5th October, 1911, at Geraldton.
Friday, the 6th October, 1911, at Beverley.*
