NOTICE is hereby given that, at a meeting of the Executive Council held this day, His Excellency the Governor, in pursuance of Section 43 of "The Constitution Act Amendment Act, 1899," was pleased to designate and declare the office of "Attorney General and Minister for Education" to be one of the six principal Executive Offices of the Government, in lieu of the Office of "Minister for Justice and Education," which His Excellency designated and declared to be one of the six principal Executive Offices of the Government on the 7th day of October, 1911.

His Excellency the Governor afterwards administered the oath of allegiance and the oath of office as Attorney General to the Honourable Thomas Walker, who up to that time had held the office of "Minister for Justice and Education."
