ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 9th day of August, 1912.

WHEREAS by Section 11 of "The Public Works Act, 1902," it is made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, to authorise the Minister for Works to undertake, construct, or provide any public work, and such authorisation is deemed an authority to such Minister by and under that Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the consent and advice of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the power conferred by the recited section of "The Public Works Act, 1902," doth hereby authorise the Honourable Minister for Works to construct in the City of Perth, Public Markets Cold Storage and Refrigerating Works, and the buildings and structures necessary for such purposes, on the land described in the Plan numbered P.W.D., W.A., 16593, which may be inspected at the office of the Minister for Works, Perth.
