

THE ASSOCIATIONS INCORPORATION ACT,
1895.

I, EDWARD YEOLAND BUTLER, of Perth, in the State of Western Australia, Civil Servant, the person hereunto authorised by "The Civil Service Club of Western Australia," do hereby give notice that I am desirous that such Club should be incorporated under the provisions of "The Associations Incorporation Act, 1895."

The following is a copy of the Memorial intended to be filed in the Supreme Court under the provisions of the said Act:—

1. Name of the institution: The Civil Service Club of Western Australia.

2. Object or purpose of the institution:

- i. To establish, maintain, and conduct a club of a non-political character for the accommodation of the members of the club, and their friends, and to provide a club house and other conveniences, and generally to afford to members and their friends all the usual privileges, advantages, convenience, and accommodation of a club.
- ii. To encourage *esprit de corps* amongst members of the Imperial, Commonwealth, and State Civil Service and to afford them an opportunity of fraternising and becoming better acquainted.
- iii. To borrow or raise or secure the payment of money in such manner as the members think fit, and in particular by the issue of debentures charged upon all or any of the club property (both present and future), and to redeem or pay off any such securities.
- iv. To draw, make, accept, indorse, and issue negotiable securities or instruments of whatsoever kind or nature.
- v. To sell or dispose of the whole or any part of the assets of the club.
- vi. To do all other things incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.
- vii. To apply for, obtain, and renew from time to time a certificate or certificates under the Licensing Act for the sale of fermented and spirituous liquors.

3. Where situated or established: "Empire Buildings," corner of Barrack and Murray Streets, Perth.

4. The name or names of the trustee or trustees: L. S. Eliot, Esq., Under Treasurer; A. Green, Esq., Commonwealth Public Service Inspector; F. L. Stow, Esq., LL.D., Crown Solicitor.

5. In whom the management of the institution is vested, and by what means: In a president, four vice-presidents, and eight committeemen periodically elected by the members. The Rules and By-laws provide for the management.
