THE LICENSED SURVEYORS' ACT, 1909.

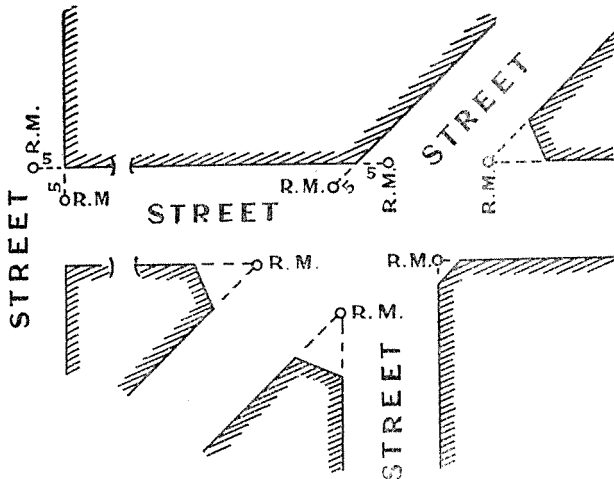
IT is hereby notified, for general information, that His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has been pleased to approve of the cancellation of Clause 47 of the General Regulations for the Guidance of Surveyors and the substitution of the following in lieu thereof, to take effect forthwith:—

Clause 47.—Street or road intersections shall be referenced as follows:—

Two corners.—Two Reference Marks shall be placed at distances of five (5) links from one of the corners on the alignments produced.

Four or more corners.—At least two corners shall be similarly referenced.

In cases where the angles have been excised from the corner allotments and included in the streets, Reference Marks shall be placed at all the intersections of the street alignments (see diagram).



Reference Marks to be of galvanised iron tube, iron bar, or glass, and not less than half-inch diameter and 15 inches long. The upper surface of the mark shall be sunk at least six inches below the natural surface of the ground.
