PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency Major General Sir
TO WIT. } Harry Barron, Knight Commander of
HARRY BARRON, } the Most Distinguished Order of St.
Governor. } Michael and St. George, Commander
of the Royal Victorian Order, Governor
[L.s.] } in and over the State of Western
Australia and its Dependencies, in
the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by "The Electoral Act, 1907," it is provided that new Rolls for any Province or District and new Rolls generally shall be prepared under the supervision of, and issued by, the Chief Electoral Officer, whenever directed by Proclamation, and shall come into operation at a date to be stated in the same or any subsequent Proclamation: And whereas the Chief Electoral Officer was directed by Proclamation dated the fourteenth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixteen, to prepare under his supervision and issue

new Rolls for each District: And whereas the new Rolls for the Moore, Canning, Murray-Wellington, Northam, and Sussex Districts were duly prepared and issued: Now therefore I, the said Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby fix Thursday, the seventeenth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and sixteen, as the date upon which such new Rolls shall come into operation.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, the sixteenth day of August, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixteen.
