

WHEREAS the NARROGIN Road Board, by resolution passed at a meeting of the Board, held at Narrogin on the 30th day of March, 1916, resolved to open the road hereinafter described, that is to say:—

Corres. 545/06.

No. 5696.—A strip of land (Crown), one chain wide, leaving Road No. 3419 near the North-West corner of Williams Location 4450, and extending (as shown Plan Yillimining 287) North through late Reserve No. 10172 to a surveyed road along the South boundary of Reserve No. 10058. (Plan 385B/40, E1.)

WHEREAS the MERREDIN (now Westonia) Road Board, by resolution passed at a meeting of the Board, held at Merredin on the 12th day of May, 1915, resolved to open the road hereinafter described, that is to say:—

Corres. 1714/15.

No. 5697.—A strip of land (Crown), one chain wide, leaving a surveyed road in Reserve No. 14983, and extending as surveyed (O.P. Perth 1984) North-Westward and West, passing through Mining Leases 2241, 2259, and 2843 to Emily Street in the West Westonia Sub-division; thence (150 links wide) North (widening at its commencement) following Emily Street and continuing (as shown Diagram P. 1986) to and through Mining Lease 2827 to its North boundary. (Plan 35/80, D & E 3.)

And whereas the Governor in Executive Council has confirmed the said resolutions, it is hereby notified that the lines of communication described above are roads within the meaning of "The Roads Act, 1911," subject to the provisions of the said Act.
