WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 3 of "The Health Act, 1911-15," that the term "Infectious disease" means and includes certain specified diseases, and also any other disease which the Governor may bring under the provisions of the Act: And whereas it is desired to bring under the provisions of the Act the disease known as Anthrax: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieut.-Governor of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby bring under the provisions of the said Act the disease above mentioned, that is to say, Anthrax.

FREMANTLE HARBOUR TRUST.

Deepening Operations in Inner Harbour and Entrance Channel—Dredges, Drilling Stage and Drilling Punt or Barge.

Notice to Mariners.

C.S.O. 825/17.

FURTHER to Notice to Mariners dated 14th February, 1917 (No. 15205, C.S.O.), it is hereby further notified that on and after 15th April, 1917, the following will apply, viz.:—

In respect to dredges working in the Inner Harbour and Entrance Channel leading thereto, Mariners approaching must use the whistle (sound) signals laid down in Article No. 28 of the Board of Trade Regulations for preventing collisions, viz.:—

One short blast—"I am directing my course to starboard,"

Two short blasts—"I am directing my course to port,"

upon which the dredge will haul as far as possible towards the edge of the Channel opposite to the side upon which the approaching vessel signifies as above that she desires to use. Approaching Mariners must be careful in using these sound signals to give sufficient time for the dredge to move as indicated.

In respect to the drilling stage, a black disc will be displayed on this stage by day on the side upon which approaching vessels are to pass, and by night the side upon which vessels are to pass will be denoted by two green lights placed vertically if the passing side is on the Northern hand of the stage and two red lights placed vertically if the passing side is on the Southern hand of the stage. These lights will be two feet apart, and will be shown from the top of the drilling attachment or approximately 40ft. above water level.

In respect to the floating drilling punt or barge, this barge is drawn to the edge of the channel each night, and its position will be denoted by white lights as heretofore.
