### PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by "The Constitution Act, 1889," it is provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor to prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly from time to time, by Proclamation or otherwise, whenever he shall think fit: And whereas the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly now stand prorogued to the 28th day of June instant, and it is desirable to further prorogue the same: Now therefore I, the said Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby further prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly as from and after the 28th day of June instant until the 19th day of July next.

WHEREAS by Section 9 of "The Land Act, 1898," the Governor may resume, for any of the purposes specified in Section 39 of the said Act, any portion of land held as a Grazing Lease; And whereas it is deemed ex-

pedient that the portion of Grazing Lease No. 2133/68 (Avon Location 6693), as described hereunder, should be resumed for one of the purposes specified in paragraph 8 of Section 39 of the said Act, that is to say for "Townsite": Now therefore I, Sir William Grey Ellison-Macartney, Governor as aforesaid, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my proclamation resume portion of Grazing Lease No. 2133/68. for the purpose aforesaid.

WHEREAS by Section 9 of "The Land Act, 1898," the Governor may resume, for any of the purposes specified in Section 39 of the said Act, any portion of land held as a Grazing Lease or Conditional Purchase: And whereas it is deemed expedient that the portion of Grazing Lease 6683/68 and Conditional Purchase 29221/55 (Avon Location 18135), as described hereunder, should be resumed for one of the purposes specified in paragraph 9 of Section 39 of the said Act, that is to say for "Cemetery": Now therefore I, Sir William Grey Ellison-Macartney, Governor as aforesaid, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my proclamation resume portion of Grazing Lease 6683/68 and
